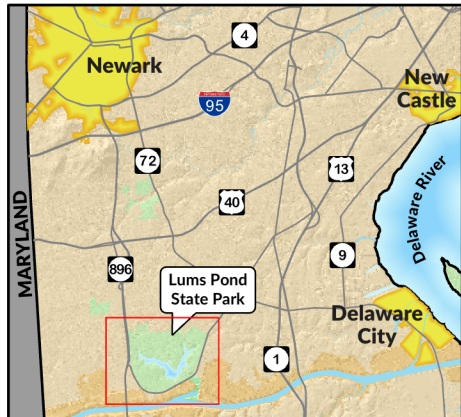


Lums Pond State Park

Trail Descriptions

Little Jersey

Trail Width	Surface Type	Trail Grade	Accessible
Avg 8 Feet Min 6 Feet	Packed Earth Crushed Stone	Avg 2% Max 11%	 - Yes

The Little Jersey loops around the park through forests and along field edges providing visitors with a full appreciation of the park's natural beauty. The packed earth surface is wide enough to accommodate shared-use among hikers, bikers, and equestrians. Visitors can access the trail across from the Nature Center, at the Buck Jersey Road Parking Lot, or the boat launch off Red Lion Road. Please remember

Swamp Forest

Trail Width	Surface Type	Trail Grade	Accessible
Avg 3 Feet Min 2 Feet	Packed Earth Crushed Stone	Avg 2% Max 10%	 - No

The Swamp Forest Trail loops through forested wetlands of black cherry, sweet gum, and maple. Hikers will experience a packed earth and crushed stone trail that traverses gentle terrain with many elevated boardwalks and bridges. The trail links the campground, boat launch, disc golf course, dog training area, nature center and picnic areas.

Whale Wallow Loop

This 0.1 mile boardwalk trail is accessible from behind the Nature Center. The trail provides a sensory experience of the natural world.

Mile Loop Trail

This one mile packed earth loop trail is accessible from the Area 4 picnic pavilion.
