

Milan Hill State Park

Camping Information

About the Campground

This quiet campground is located 2.5 miles up Route 110B off Route 16 in the town of Milan, NH approximately 10 miles north of Berlin. It offers 4 yurts, 2 lean-tos and 4 campsites with tent platforms of varying sizes. All sites are reservable through ReserveAmerica. The campground is open from mid-May to late October, weather permitting.

Facilities, Services and Amenities

Pit toilets and water faucets are available throughout the campground loop. The day-use area offers a picnic shelter, hilltop picnic sites, and a fire tower.

Activities

The campground is located near popular areas for fishing, canoeing, kayaking, wildlife viewing, hunting, and ATVing. From this hilltop campground, and the firetower located there, you can get a complete view of mountain ranges in New Hampshire, Maine, Vermont, and Canada

About the Policies

- Check-in time is after 1 pm. Check-out time is before 11am.
- Payment is made online through the ReserveAmerica website. Payment for “walk-in” camping can be made at the campground office or by completing a self-registration envelope with cash and deposited in the “Iron Ranger” at the campground office.
- Reservation fees cover 2 adults and 4 children. Additional adults are \$10.00 per person per night. Additional children are \$5.00 per person. All sites except for site 4 are a maximum of 6 individuals. Site 4 is a group site with a maximum of 16 individuals.
- Quiet hours are from 10 pm - 7 am.
- Day-use visitors are welcome to the picnic area or to visit friends and family camping in the park. As there is no day-use fee, visitors are requested to make a donation for maintenance and upkeep of the park.
- Pets are permitted in the park if leashed and attended at all times.
- Cutting standing trees and shrubs and using power saws is prohibited.
- Do not wash dishes or brush teeth at water faucets.
- This is a carry-in/ carry-out park for all day-use trash.
- Registered campers can deposit their trash in the park dumpster. Recycling bins are available in the park.
- The speed limit on all park roads is 10 miles an hour.

- Firewood is available for purchase at the campground office. It is unlawful to bring firewood to the park from out of state locations. (RSA227-K:17).

For Your Safety

Do not invite wildlife into the campground or to your campsite. Keep a clean site, dispose of food waste properly and secure all food and heavily scented items in your vehicle at night. Coolers left out are easily opened by raccoons or destroyed by bears.

Making a Reservation

Reservations may be made by calling ReserveAmerica at 1-877-647-2757 or online at nhstateparks.org. Reservations for organized youth group camping are required and should be made by calling the Concord Office at (603) 271-3556. Youth group reservations are not available online.

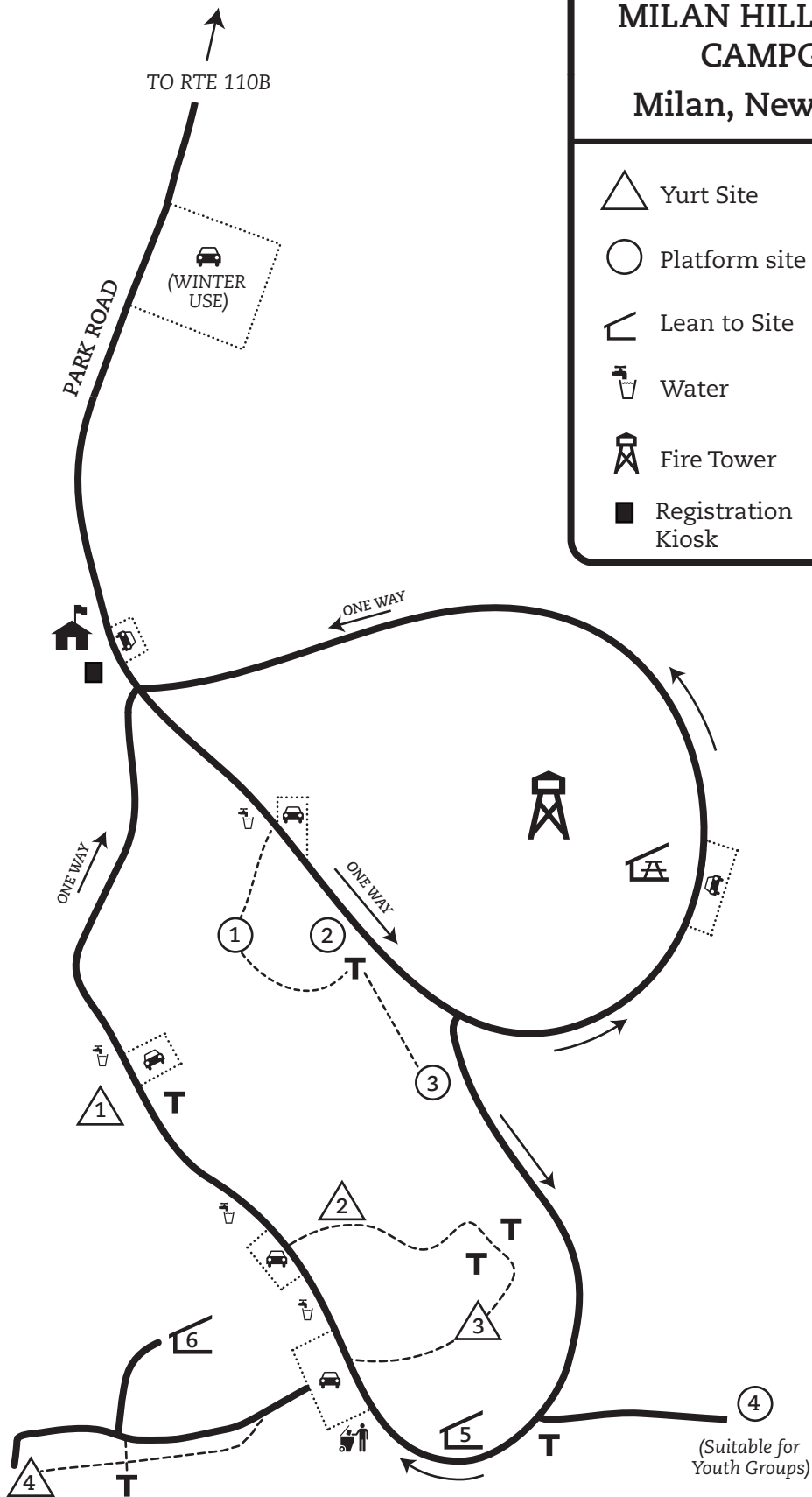
