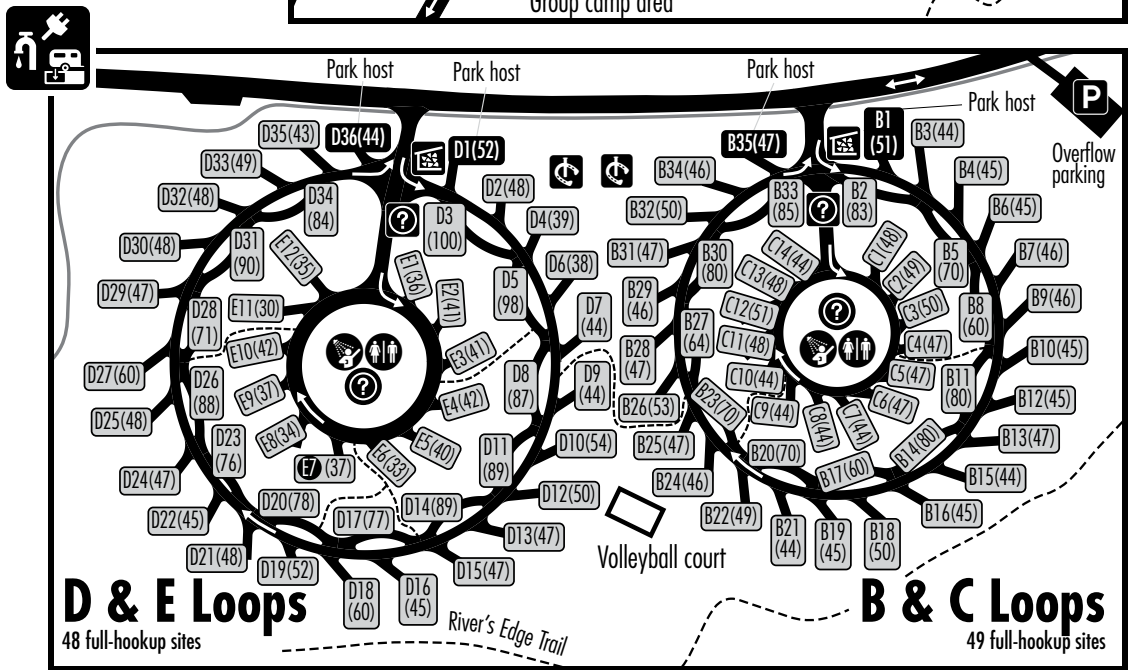
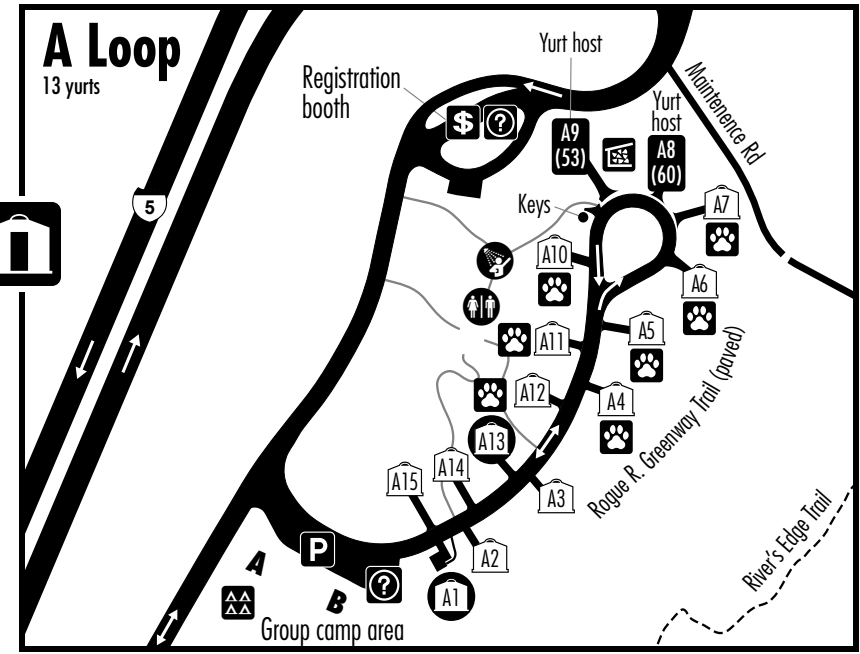
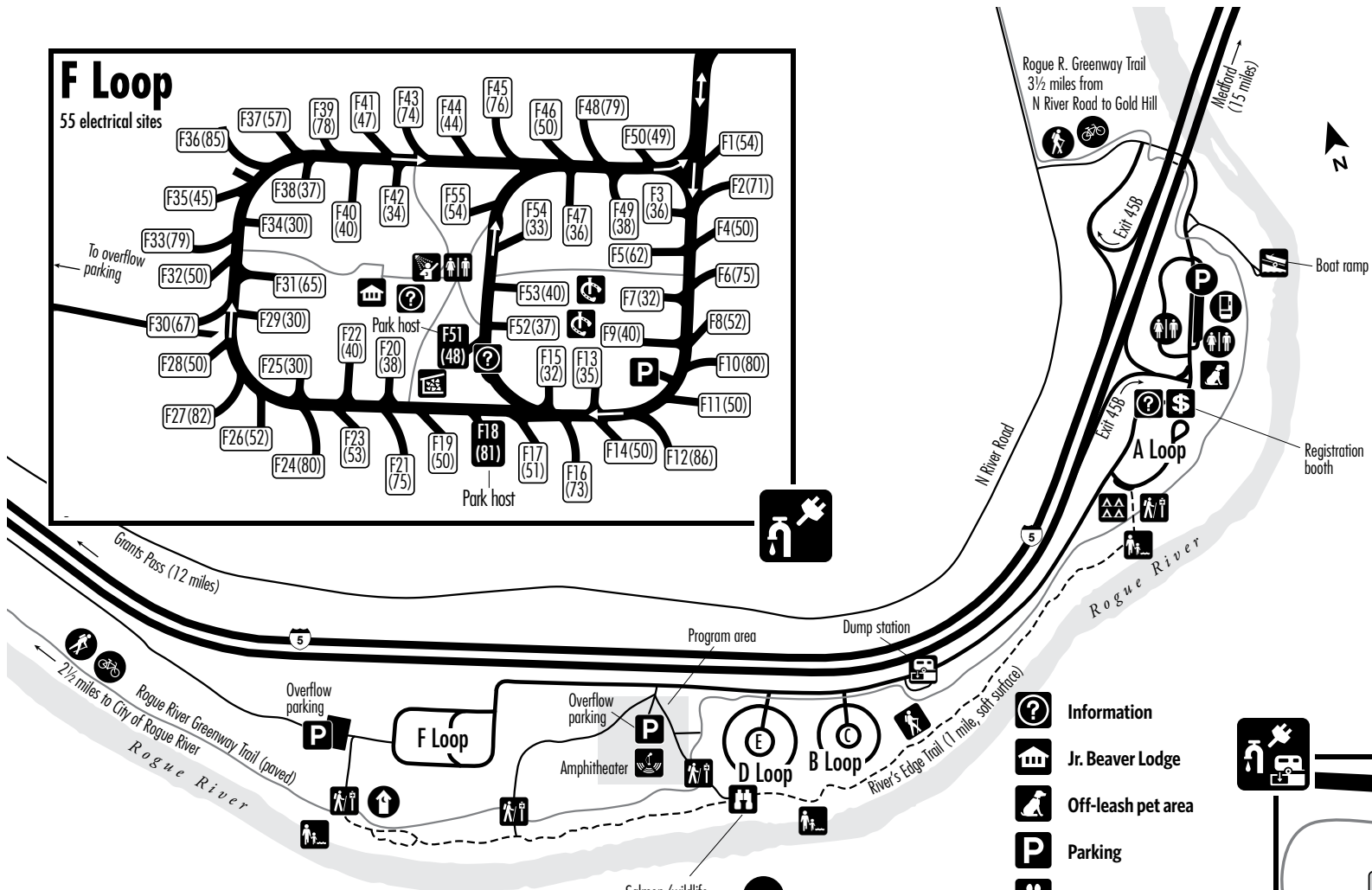




**Check in: 4 p.m.**

**Check out: 1 p.m.**

**Quiet hours: 10 p.m. - 7 a.m.**

- All vehicles must be parked on pavement.
- Bicycles are permitted only on designated bike paths and park roads following the flow of traffic. Helmets required for riders under 16.
- Please adhere to the 15 mph speed limit in the campground.
- Use the RV dump station when dumping a full holding tank.
- Pets are required to be on leash (6' max) and attended at all times. Please pick up all waste.
- No metal detecting allowed on park property.



# CAMPGROUND GUIDELINES

## VEHICLES

- All vehicles must be parked on asphalt pad.
- If a vehicle does not fit on the asphalt pad, it must be parked in **overflow parking**, indicated on the map.
- No offroad driving or parking allowed.

## FIREWOOD SALES

Please see information kiosks for current hours. Firewood is also available in the towns of Rogue River and Gold Hill.

- \$7 per bundle.
- Purchase at host sites A-8, B-1, D-1, and F-18.
- Gathering of firewood is prohibited.
- Out-of-state firewood is not allowed on park property.

## FIRE PITS

Please burn firewood only. Burning pallets, treated lumber, trash, plastic, or glass is prohibited.

## FOOD

Food should be stowed in secure containers. Wildlife will tear through food and garbage bags.

## TRASH

Dumpsters are available in each campground loop.

## PETS

- Pets must remain on a leash with a maximum length of six feet.
- Please **clean up** after your pet and **never leave it unattended**.
- Bags are provided for your convenience near host sites in each camp loop.
- Pets are not allowed in restrooms or yurts, except for pet-friendly yurts.
- Off-leash pet area located in day-use area.

## RIVER ACCESS

The river is swift and cold; please be careful. Limited access at:

- The boat ramp.
- River's Edge Trail- you will see many foot paths towards river.

## SWIMMING POOLS

- Child size "Kiddie Pools" only.
- Must be on hardscape.
- Must supply your own water; the park has limited supply.
- Water must be drained nightly for safety.

## INTERPRETIVE EVENTS

Programs are held May-September. Please see information kiosks for details.

## JUNIOR RANGER PROGRAM

Programs for kids ages 6-12 offered May-September. Please see information kiosks for schedule and locations.
