

Fowlers Hollow and Tuscarora Area Trails



The 104-acre Fowlers Hollow State Park is in a narrow valley created by Fowler Hollow Run. Situated on the edge of the 96,000-acre Tuscarora State Forest, Fowlers Hollow State Park makes a good base for adventures like hiking, horseback riding, cross-country skiing, snowmobiling, and more. Follow all rules and regulations during your visit and enjoy your Pennsylvania public lands!



Hiking Trails

ALFARATA TRAIL
0.5 mile | Easiest hiking
Recreations permitted: hiking, equestrian, snowmobiling
This trail connects Fowlers Hollow Road with Perry Lumber Company Road.

BEASTON TRAIL
1.1 miles | More difficult hiking
Recreations permitted: hiking, equestrian, snowmobiling
This gravel road connects Couch Road with Fowlers Hollow Road.

BISTLINE FORD TRAIL
1.8 miles | Most difficult hiking
Recreations permitted: hiking, equestrian, snowmobiling
This trail connects Fowlers Hollow Road with Couch Road through a mostly deciduous forest filled with numerous spring seeps.

FOWLERS HOLLOW ROAD
1.2 miles (gate to first trail junction) | More difficult hiking
Recreations permitted: hiking, equestrian, snowmobiling
A scenic hike, this road parallels Fowler Hollow Run, connecting users to Perry Lumber Company Road. Horseback riding is prohibited within the state park campground.

HART RIDGE TRAIL
1.6 miles | Most difficult hiking
Recreations permitted: hiking, equestrian
Connecting Fowlers Hollow Road with Bistline Ford Trail, this hike leads you into Tuscarora State Forest where you will pass an old CCC chimney and a lean-to.

PERRY LUMBER COMPANY ROAD
4.7 miles | Easiest hiking
Recreations permitted: hiking, equestrian
A hike through bottomland forest begins at Hemlock Road and extends west. The trail section between Hemlock Road and Alfarata Trail is open to snowmobiling.

PERRY LUMBER COMPANY TRAIL
1.8 miles | More difficult hiking
Recreations permitted: hiking, equestrian
Following an old logging railroad grade, this trail forms a loop when combined with Perry Lumber Company Road.

TWIG TRAIL
1.3 miles | More difficult hiking
Recreations permitted: hiking, equestrian
This old logging road connects Hemlock Road to Perry Lumber Company Trail and Perry Lumber Company Road while overlooking the hollow below.

Hike Safely

- Have a plan. Let someone know where you are going and when you expect to return.
- Cell service is spotty at best, plan accordingly.
- At a minimum, carry the following items: water, snacks, whistle, map, flashlight.
- Know your physical limitations.
- Stay on marked trails.
- Supervise children closely.
- Report lost or late hikers to the park or forestry rangers immediately.
