

Hickory Run State Park

This campground has modern campsites (electric, non-electric, full-hookup, pet-friendly, and walk-to), camping cottages, deluxe cottages, and glamping sites. A camp store sells general camping supplies.

Three camping cottages sleep five guests in bunk beds, and have a table, chairs, heat, lights, outlets, porch, picnic table, and fire ring.

The two deluxe cottages have a bedroom and main room, stove, refrigerator, table, chairs, countertop, heat, outlets, fire ring, picnic table, and sleep six guests in bunk beds.

Eight glamping sites are available in partnership with Timberline Glamping. Glamp in comfort and style in a spacious safari tent featuring hotel-style beds with linens, air conditioning, heat, outlets, refrigerator, and coffee maker.

Cottages and glamping sites do not have running water, but restrooms are nearby.

State Park Reservations: Most campsites can be reserved 11 months in advance to noon of the day of arrival. For reservations, cancellations, or changes prior to arrival, contact the Pennsylvania State Parks Reservation Center at 888-PA-PARKS or www.pa.gov/state-parks.

Glamping Reservations: Glamping sites must be reserved in advance through Timberline Glamping. www.campspot.com/book/tlglamping-hickoryrunstatepark

Campsite Issuing: Unreserved sites are available on a first-come, first-served basis. If an employee is not available, read posted instructions and check the site availability listing. The appropriate fee must be paid before setting up on a campsite.

Fees: For complete information on fees, cancellations, changes, transfers, and discount policies, view the Reservation Cancellation/Change Policy on the Pennsylvania State Park website.

Campground Rules

Camping Season: The campground opens in mid-April and closes in mid-December. Shower facilities and the dump station are not available after mid-October.

Check-in/Check-out: Check-in time is 3:00 PM. Campsites must be vacated by 3:00 PM. Cottages and glamping sites must be vacated by 10:00 AM.

Alcoholic Beverages: Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in all Pennsylvania state parks.

Pets: Pets are permitted at designated campsites in this campground. Please contact the park office for pet guidelines.

Pets are prohibited in swimming areas, buildings, and all overnight facilities not participating in the pet program. Guide dogs and service dogs are not considered pets.

Noise: Campers must minimize noise between the hours of 9:00 PM and 8:00 AM. Operation of electric generators that create excessive noise is prohibited.

Occupancy: Site occupancy is limited to one family or five unrelated people, one of which must be 18 years of age or older at all times.

Motor Vehicles: Park only in designated areas. Only one vehicle is permitted at a campsite in addition to a camping unit. If permitted, additional vehicles can park on the camping spur for a fee or in the second car parking area at no charge.

Minimum/Maximum Camping Period: Campers may stay in a state park campground up to 14 consecutive nights from Memorial Day to Labor Day. If reserving a Saturday during the summer season, a two-night minimum stay is required. Campers may camp up to 21 consecutive nights during the remainder of the year.

Protect and Preserve Our Parks

Please make your visit safe and enjoyable. Obey all posted rules and regulations and respect fellow visitors and the resources of the park.

- Prevent wild fires. Fires are only permitted in fire rings or grills. Fires must be attended at all times and extinguished before leaving a campsite. Properly dispose of hot coals.
- Firewood is not provided. Cutting live or standing trees and the operation of chainsaws are prohibited.
- Because uncontrolled pets may chase wildlife or frighten visitors, pets must be physically controlled, attended at all times, and on a leash, caged, or crated. Electronic fences and leashes are prohibited.

Bear Truths: Hickory Run State Park provides the perfect habitat for black bears. A black bear can climb up a tree like a raccoon and sprint up to 35 mph. Bears use their claws to tear apart logs to find food as well as open trash cans and coolers.

Black bears have an excellent sense of smell. Aromatic scents coming from your food and toiletries can attract a hungry bear from a great distance. Keep your campsite clean. Store all food and scented items inside a locked vehicle. This practice will prevent bears and other wildlife from visiting your campsite at night. Do not hang garbage from the hook on the lantern pole provided at each site. Feeding bears is illegal.

Black bears normally avoid people, but bears dependent on eating human food can become aggressive when people get between them and food. Never approach a bear, especially a mother with cubs.

If you encounter a black bear, do not run. Back away slowly without making direct eye contact. If the bear does not leave the area, make a loud noise like blowing a whistle, honking a car horn, or banging a pot. Notify a park employee if you have difficulties with bears, and call 911 if it is an emergency.

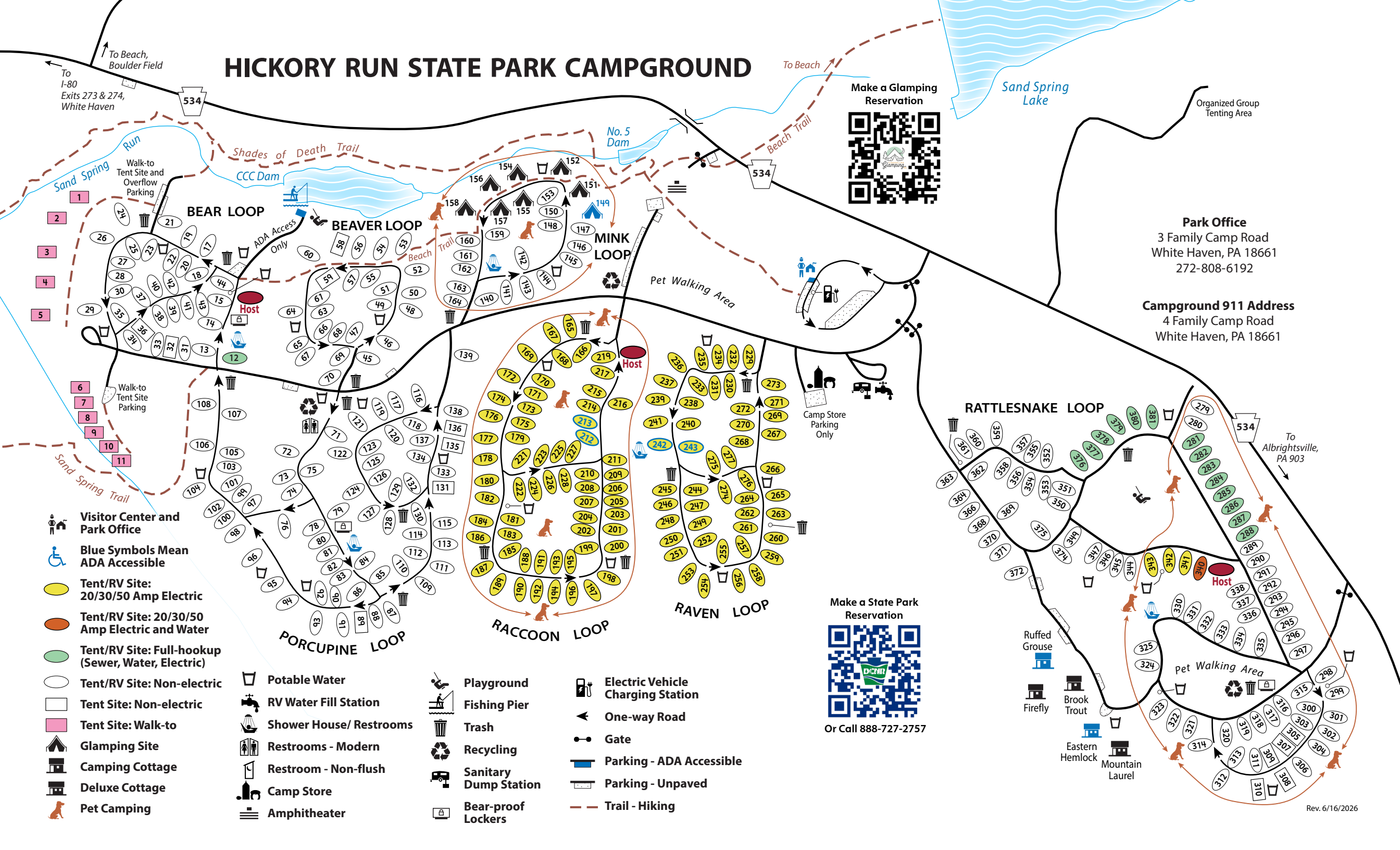
