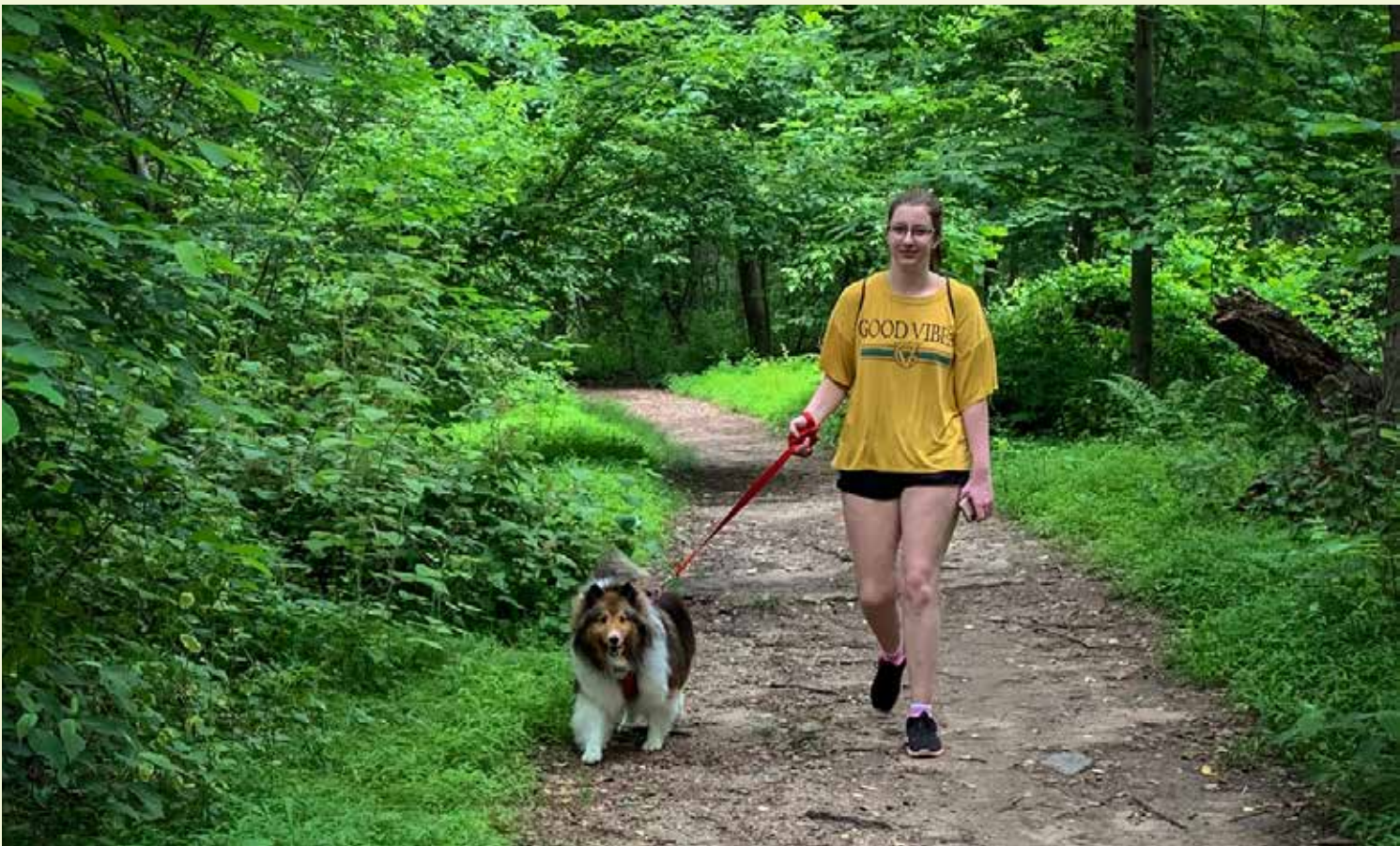




Most trails allow hiking and biking. Eagles Forest Trails and River Walk and its connectors are hiking only.

Beaver Lane
0.29 mile | Easiest hiking | Connector trail
Trailhead amenities: benches

On this gravel trail between Logan Walk and Oak Lane, enjoy a quiet, wooded area of the park.

Buck Alley
0.26 mile | Easiest hiking | Connector trail
On this gravel trail between East Walk and Locust Lane, walk through a wooded area and look for deer.

Delaware Drive
0.24 mile | Easiest hiking | Connector trail
Trailhead amenities: benches, picnic tables
Paralleling Delaware Drive between Logan Walk and River Walk, this gravel path leads to Logan Point. At the end of this trail is a view of Philadelphia across the Delaware River.

Eagles Forest Trails
0.4 mile | Easiest hiking | Connector trail
Trailhead amenities: modern restroom
The trails wind through the Eagles Forest Area of the park. Look for waysides along the trail which provide information about the trees and forest.

East Walk
0.17 mile | Easiest hiking | Out-and-back trail
Trailhead amenities: picnic tables
This paved trail borders the swimming pool and the shaded picnic area.

Locust Lane
0.58 mile | Easiest hiking | Out-and-back trail
Accessed from Lot 4, this gravel trail is surrounded by locust trees in a forested area of the park.

Logan Garden Trail
0.5 mile | Easiest hiking | Connector trail
This trail winds around the restored Logan Garden Area. Once a formal garden, the area is now maintained by dedicated volunteers.

Logan Walk
0.57 mile | Easiest hiking | Out-and-back trail
Trailhead amenities: modern restrooms, picnic tables, benches
This is the original drive to the former Robert Logan home, which has been removed. The paved, tree-lined walk is used by visitors for numerous recreational activities.

Oak Lane
0.24 mile | Easiest hiking | Connector trail
Connecting Logan Walk to Beaver Lane and River Walk, this shaded gravel path passes through mature forest.

Playground Road
0.14 mile | Easiest hiking | Out-and-back trail
Trailhead amenities: picnic tables, benches
This paved trail travels past the playground and Pavilion 3.

River Walk
0.92 mile | Easiest hiking | Connector trail
Trailhead amenities: benches
River Walk takes hikers alongside the Delaware River and Neshaminy Creek. Observe scenic views of the water and the Philadelphia skyline.

Soil Factory Trail
0.8 mile | Easiest hiking | Out-and-back trail
Once used as a deposit site for compost from Philadelphia, this area has different types of vegetation and ground cover around mounds of soil deposits. This program was discontinued in 1992, but the area still looks significantly different from the rest of the park.



South Walk
0.17 mile | Easiest hiking | Connector trail
Trailhead amenities: modern restrooms, picnic tables
Trail winds along the edge of the picnic area next to the Eagles Forest and connects to multiple trails on the western side of the park.

West Walk
0.17 mile | Easiest hiking | Connector trail
Trailhead amenities: picnic tables
Connecting Logan Walk to South Walk, this gravel and paved trail borders the swimming pool and the playground and connects to multiple trails on the western side of the park.

Winks Lane
0.48 mile | Easiest hiking | Connector trail
Trailhead amenities: modern restrooms, picnic tables
This paved trail winds through the wooded picnic area.
