

Pricing and Reservations

Pricing: Lodging prices vary due to type of facility; number of guests the facility accommodates; Pennsylvania residency status; length of stay; week; and season.

Please note, base pricing information does not include fees or taxes.

State Park Reservations: Most facilities can be reserved 11 months in advance to noon of the day of arrival. For reservations, cancellations, or changes prior to arrival, contact the Pennsylvania State Parks Reservation Center at 888-PA-PARKS or www.pa.gov/stateparks.

Fees: A non-refundable transaction fee is charged for each reservation.

Cabin, lodge, unique house, and prices incur additional state and/or county local tax(es). The county local hotel occupancy tax rate varies depending on the location in the Commonwealth.

Designated dog-friendly facilities charge an additional fee per night.

For complete information on fees, cancellations, changes, transfers, and discount policies, view the Reservation Cancellation/Change Policy on the Pennsylvania State Park website.

Minimum/Maximum Stay: From mid-June to mid-August, all cabins must be rented for a one week period, beginning on a Friday.

During the remainder of the year, cabins may be rented for a minimum of two days, up to a maximum of 14 consecutive days.

Nockamixon State Park

The 5,286-acre Nockamixon State Park is in the rolling hills of scenic Bucks County, close enough to Philadelphia for a day trip, but far enough away for a vacation.

Tohickon Creek, Three Mile Run, and Haycock Run feed the 1,450-acre Lake Nockamixon, which is a rest stop for migrating waterfowl and a destination for boaters and anglers.

Visitors can stay the night in a cabin or enjoy the many activities of the park for the day. Popular activities are picnicking, swimming in the pool, hiking, biking, hunting, fishing, and boating.



Camp Nearby

Tenting and RV camping are prohibited at Nockamixon State Park, but stay at a local campground and enjoy the beautiful park during the day.

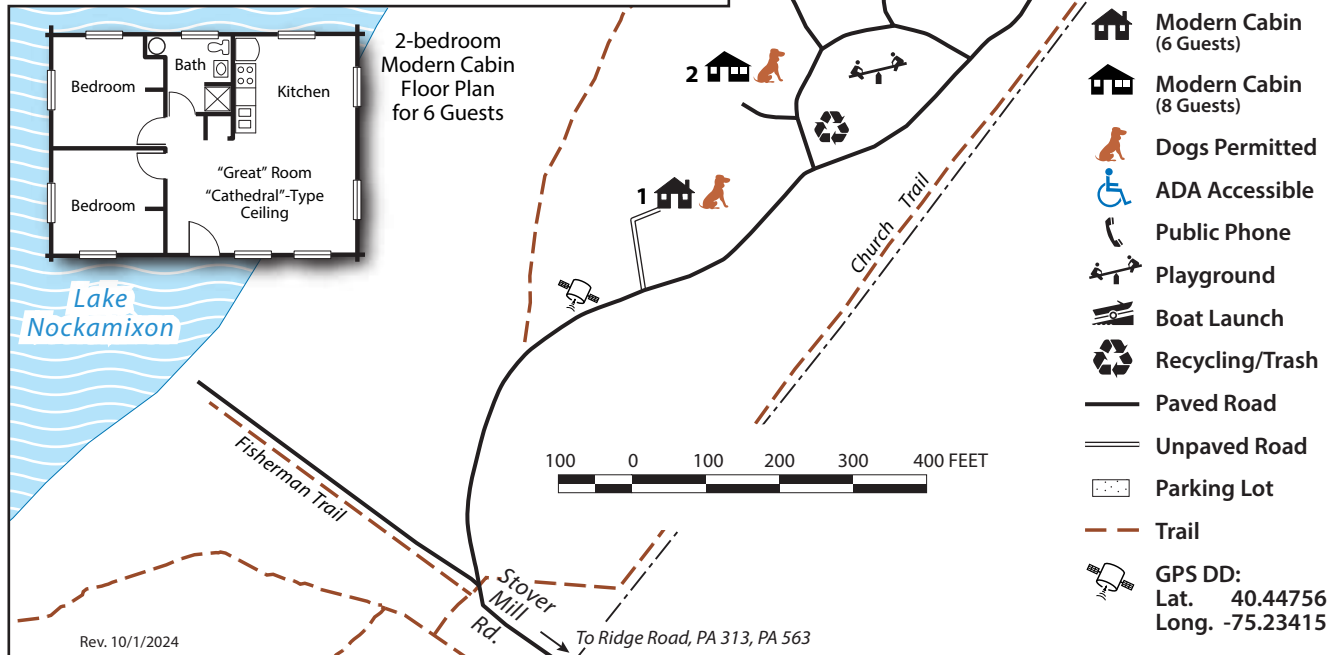

Modern Cabin Information

Modern cabins take the rough out of "roughing it" for those who enjoy comfortable accommodations. Each modern cabin offers electric heat, air conditioning, bedrooms, living room, dining area, a modern bathroom, and kitchen with refrigerator, stove, and microwave. These beautifully designed log cabins feature a wooden cathedral ceiling in the main living area and modern conveniences throughout. There are two-bedroom (sleeps 6) and three-bedroom (sleeps 8) cabins available year round. Each cabin has one double-sized bed in the master bedroom and additional twin-sized bunk beds in separate bedrooms. Cabins 1, 2, 3, and 6 permit up to two dogs. Cabin 4 and 6 are ADA accessible with a ramped sidewalk to the door, roll in shower, and accessible, sinks, counters, and light switches.

Cabins do not have Wi-Fi, but cell phone service is usually good with most network providers.



Lodging Rules

Check-in: Check-in time is 3:00 PM at the rented cabin. No early check-in.

Check-out: Lodging must be vacated by 10:00 AM. No late check-out. After cleaning the cabin, disposing of trash, and removing personal items, place the cabin key on the table.

What to Bring: All linens including sheets, blankets or sleeping bags, pillows, etc.; all cooking, serving, and eating utensils; toiletries; coffee pot; toaster; and fans.

Tents, camping trailers, RVs, and ATVs are prohibited.

Alcoholic Beverages: Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in all Pennsylvania state parks.

Pets: A maximum of two dogs are permitted in cabins 1, 2, 3, and 6 for a fee. Dogs must be under physical control at all times and are prohibited to be left unattended in cabins. Dogs must be house-trained; free of ticks, fleas, worms, and mange; not in cycle (heat); and not aggressive or vicious. Dogs must not excessively bark or be a disturbance. Extra fees will be assessed for damages.

Pets are prohibited in swimming areas, buildings, any area closed to pets, and all overnight facilities not participating in the pet program. Guide dogs and service dogs are not considered pets.

Fires: Fires are permitted in fire rings, grills, and fireplaces. Fires must be attended at all times and extinguished before leaving the area.

Firewood is not provided. Cutting live or standing trees and the operation of chainsaws are prohibited.

Quiet Hours: Campers must not disturb the sleep of others between 9:00 PM and 8:00 AM.
