

Crooked Run Campground

Crooked Run Campground is a large forested camping area with 10 loops. It has modern campsites (electric, non-electric, full-hookup, pull-thru, and pet-friendly), camping cottages, and deluxe camping cottages. In the campground, there are laundry facilities; playgrounds; general store; boat rental, launch, and mooring; swimming area; amphitheater; hiking trails; Humps & Bumps biking area; and restrooms with warm showers. ADA accessible campsites, restrooms, showers, and cottages are available.

Camping and deluxe camping cottages sleep five people in single bunk beds and double/single bunk beds. They have a dining table and chairs, electric heat, lights, outlets, porch, picnic table, and fire ring with a grill. Deluxe camping cottages also have a stovetop, microwave, and refrigerator.

Camping Season: The campground opens in mid-April and closes in late October.

State Park Reservations: Most campsites can be reserved 11 months in advance to noon of the day of arrival. For reservations, cancellations, or changes prior to arrival, contact the Pennsylvania State Parks Reservation Center at 888-PA-PARKS or www.pa.gov/state-parks.

Campsite Issuing: Unreserved sites are available on a first-come, first-served basis. If an employee is not available, read posted instructions and check the site availability listing. The appropriate fee must be paid before setting up on a campsite.

Fees: For complete information on fees, cancellations, changes, transfers, and discount policies, view the Reservation Cancellation/Change Policy on the Pennsylvania State Park website.

Campground Rules

Check-in/Check-out Time: Check-in time is 3:00 PM. Campsites must be vacated by 3:00 PM. Cottages must be vacated by 10:00 AM.

Alcoholic Beverages: Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in all Pennsylvania state parks.

Pets: Pets are permitted in designated loops and pet walking areas in this campground. Please contact the park office for pet guidelines.

Pets are prohibited in swimming areas, buildings, and all overnight facilities not participating in the pet program. Guide dogs and service dogs are not considered pets.

Quiet Hours: Campers must minimize noise between the hours of 9:00 PM and 8:00 AM.

Noise: Operation of electric generators that create excessive noise is prohibited.

Motor Vehicles: Park only in designated areas. Only one vehicle is permitted at a campsite in addition to a camping unit. All vehicles must back onto the camping spur. Parking or driving on grass is prohibited. Small camping spurs that do not accommodate a vehicle have designated parking at specified campsites. See map for locations. If permitted, additional vehicles can park on the camping spur for a fee or in the second car parking area at no charge.

Visitors: Visitors are welcome on campsites from 8:00 AM to 10:00 PM.

Minimum/Maximum Camping Period: Campers may stay in a state park campground up to 14 consecutive nights from Memorial Day to Labor Day. If reserving a Saturday during the summer season, a two-night minimum stay is required. Campers may camp up to 21 consecutive nights during the remainder of the year.

Protect and Preserve Our Parks

Please make your visit safe and enjoyable. Obey all posted rules and regulations and respect fellow visitors and the resources of the park.

- Be prepared and bring the proper equipment. Natural areas may possess hazards. Your personal safety and that of your family are your responsibility.
- Please camp only in designated areas and minimize your impact on the campsite.
- Prevent wild fires. Fires are only permitted in fire rings or grills. Fires must be attended at all times and extinguished before leaving a campsite. Properly dispose of hot coals.
- Firewood is not provided. Cutting live or standing trees and the operation of chainsaws are prohibited.
- Handwashing and dishwashing are prohibited at water spigots, hand pumps, springs, lakes, and streams.
- Because uncontrolled pets may chase wildlife or frighten visitors, pets must be physically controlled, attended at all times, and on a leash, caged, or crated. Electronic fences and leashes are prohibited.
- Do your part to keep wildlife wild! Enjoy wildlife from a safe distance and do not feed or approach wild animals. Human food is unhealthy for animals and animals dependent on human food can lead to dangerous human-animal encounters.

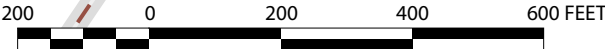
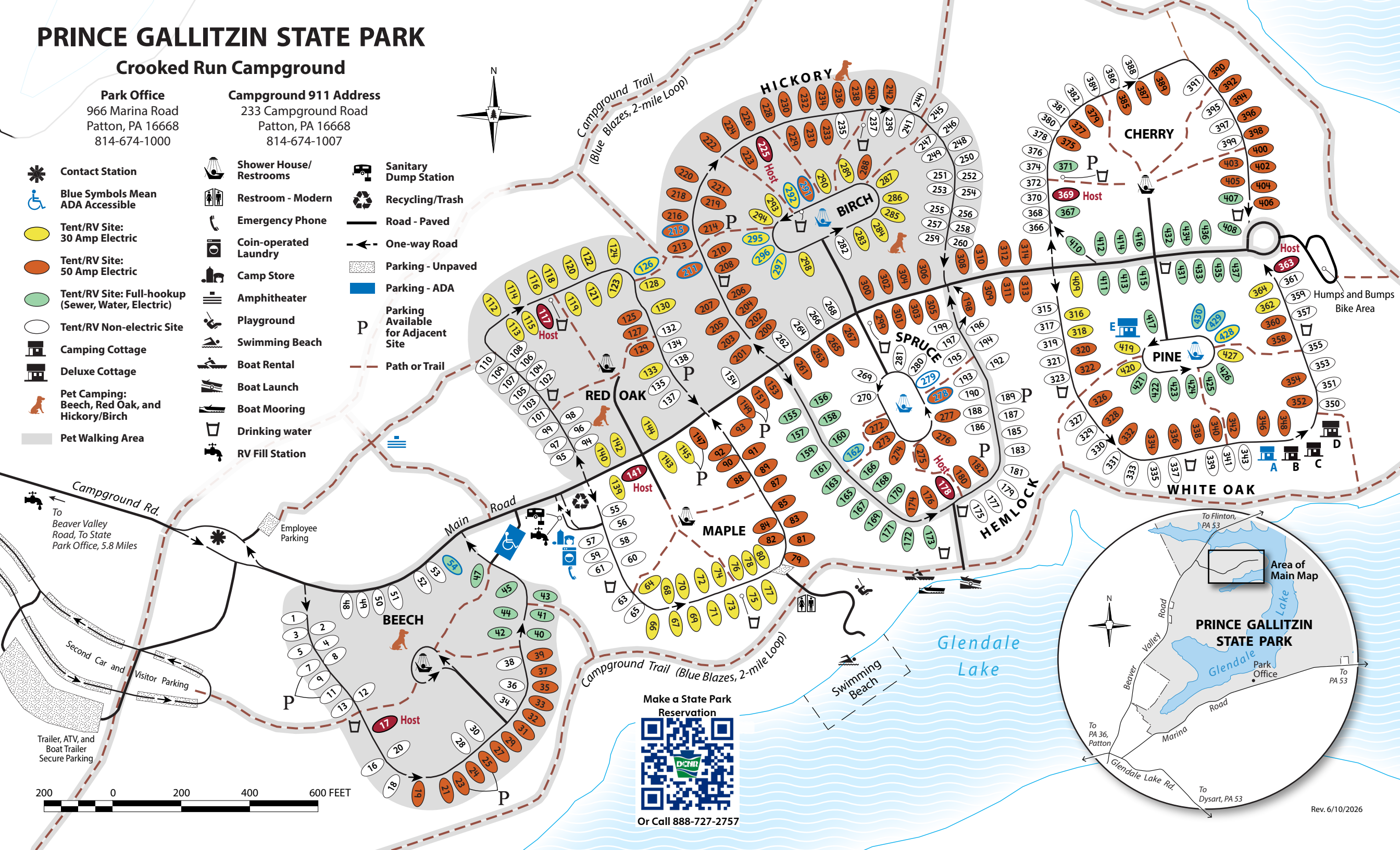
