Admission

Park admission is free. Scheduled tours are \$5 for adults and \$2.50 for SC seniors, disabled and military. Children under 6 and anyone wearing an Ultimate Outsider shirt admitted free.

PARK DESCRIPTION:

The Battle of Rivers Bridge State Historic Site commemorates one of the last battles of the American Civil War, in which Union troops of Gen. William Tecumseh Sherman's army forced a crossing of the Salkehatchie River in February of 1865. At the battlefield, visitors can see the well-preserved earthen fortifications held by Confederate defenders and the ground over which Union soldiers charged. At the memorial grounds, visitors can learn more about the casualties of the fight and how the commemoration of the battle recalled the Civil War and helped preserve the site.

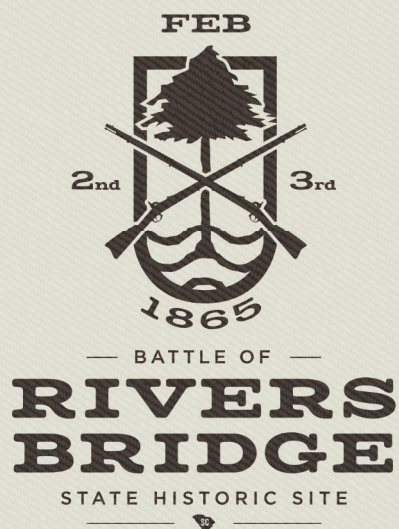
