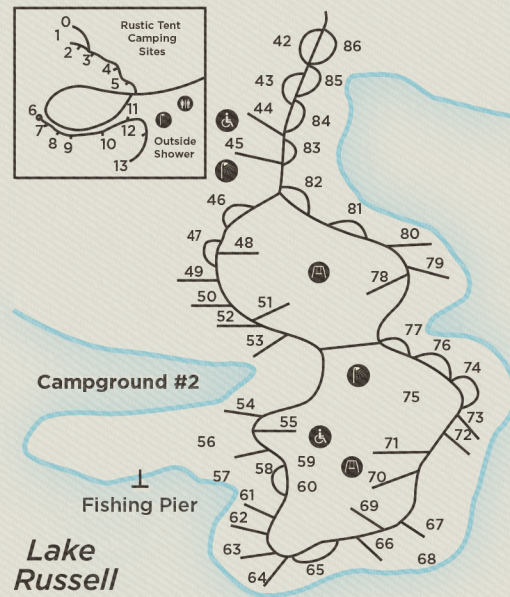
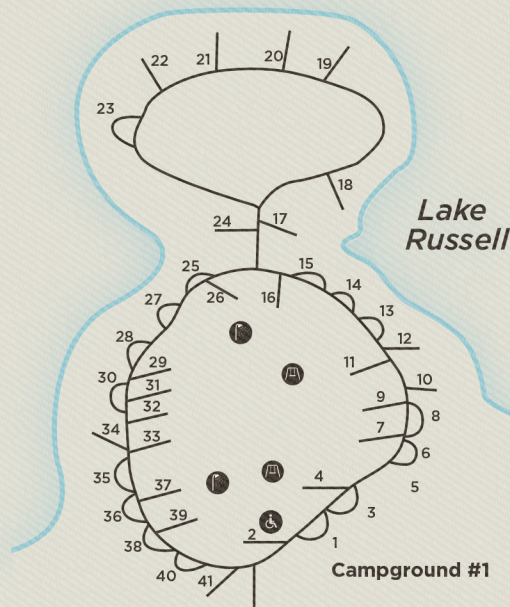

# GUIDELINES

- Dial 911 in an emergency.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- Firearms and fireworks are prohibited.
- Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. – 7 a.m. NO EXCEPTIONS, including pets.
- Tents must be on the tent pads or paved portion of the standard (RV) sites with a maximum of six people per site.
- Campers are allowed a maximum of one trailer/RV and one tent OR two tents per site.
- All vehicles must remain on paved portions of the campsite.
- No vehicles are permitted to park on grass, mulch, road shoulders, adjacent sites or other locations in the campground. Do not park on unoccupied sites.
- Campfires must be contained inside the fire ring that is provided for each site.
- No campfires on the lakeshore. Fires are allowed only in park-designated fire rings or grills.
- Standard sites are allowed a maximum of two vehicles at the site. All additional vehicles need to park in the tackle shop area and display a valid pass.
- It is unlawful to cut, damage or remove plants, shrubs or trees. Firewood is available for purchase in the Park Store.
- Tent sites T00-T13 are walk-in sites. There is no power or water, and no vehicles are allowed on sites. There is a designated parking lot near sites.
- Please take all trash and recyclables to a collection site. The collection sites are located at the entrance to the campgrounds. Dispose of waste and gray water in one of our waste dump stations designed for that purpose.
- Pets must be confined or on a leash no longer than 6 feet. Owners will be asked to remove noisy or dangerous pets or pets that threaten or harass wildlife.
- Only licensed vehicles may be operated in a state park and must remain in areas specifically intended for vehicular traffic. Golf carts must display a valid permit at all times and have a licensed driver. Golf carts may be operated only in daylight hours.
- All campsites may be reserved in advance. An empty site does not mean it is an available site.
- It is unlawful to kill, harm or harass any mammal, bird, reptile or amphibian.
- Any guest not staying overnight needs to pay for park admission.
