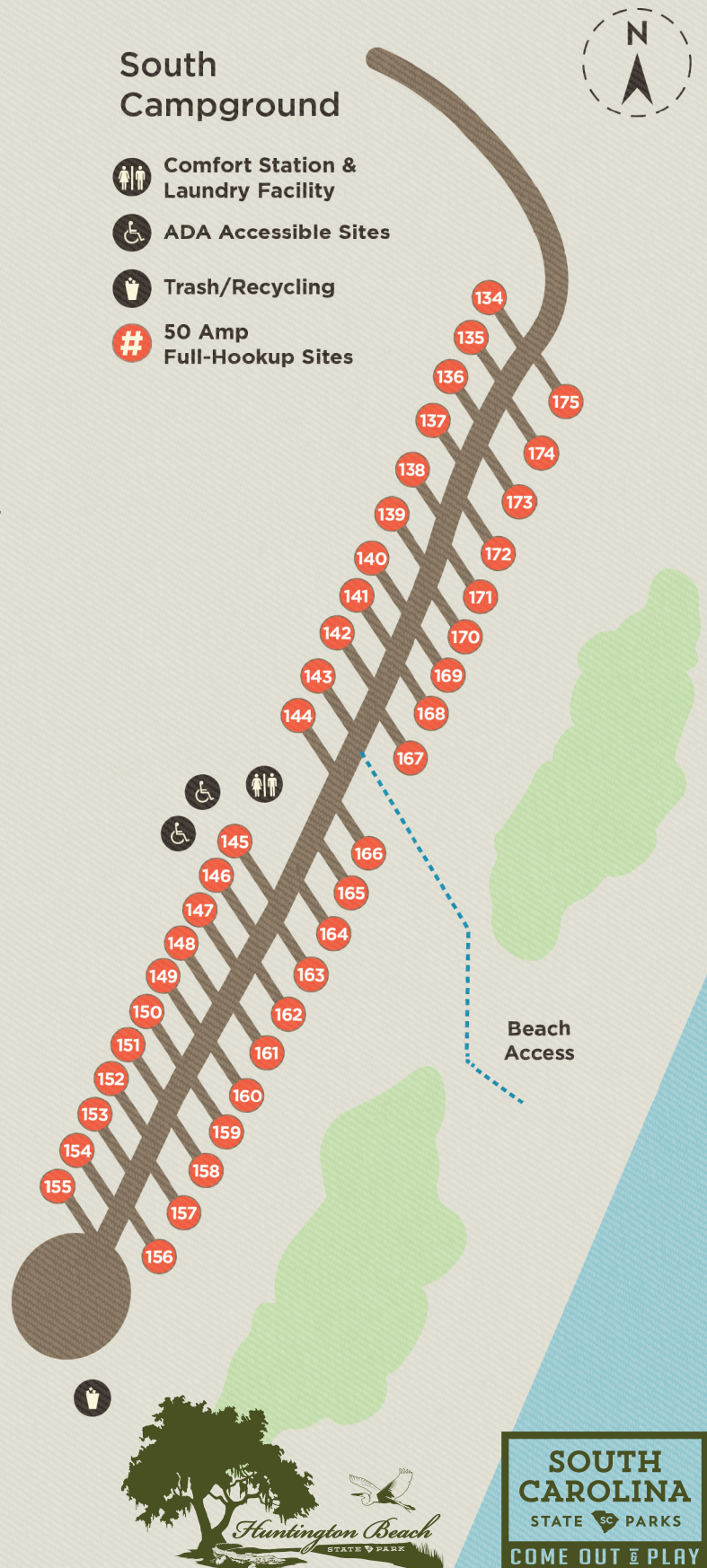
GUIDELINES

1. Camping check-in is at 2 p.m. and checkout is noon.
2. Registered campers may not change sites without permission from park staff.
3. Cancellations and changes are subject to fees based on the notice given. Early departures are subject to cancellation policies.
4. Visitors not registered for an overnight stay are required to pay admission.
5. South Carolina senior citizens (age 65 and older) and disabled South Carolina residents may register for a campsite at a reduced rate. The qualifying individual must be present for the duration of the stay.
6. Campers are allowed a maximum of one trailer/RV and one tent OR two tents per site. No more than six (6) persons may occupy the same site.
7. Two cars allowed per site. Roadside parking prohibited. Vehicles must be parked on gravel/concrete. Additional vehicles must be parked in designated overflow parking lot.
8. Only licensed vehicles may be operated in a state park and must remain in areas specifically intended for vehicular traffic. Golf carts must display a valid permit at all times.
9. Maximum length of stay on a single site is 14 nights.
10. Camping parties may not register for more than 42 consecutive nights during any 49-day period.
11. Quiet hours are 10 p.m. – 7 a.m.
12. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
13. It is unlawful to dispose of any waste, including gray water, in places or receptacles other than designated areas. Outdoor showers and shower tents are prohibited.
14. All fires must be confined to designated fire rings.
15. It is unlawful to cut, damage or remove plants, shrubs or trees.
16. It is unlawful to possess or discharge fireworks or other explosives.
17. Feeding wildlife is prohibited.
18. Pets must be on leash no longer than six feet or under physical, restrictive control at all times. Owners will be asked to remove noisy or dangerous pets or pets that threaten or harass wildlife. Dogs not permitted on certain areas of the beach. Please take note of signs designating "no dogs."
