Lake Greenwood State Park

Lake Greenwood State Park, located along the shores of its namesake lake in South Carolina's Piedmont region, is a picturesque destination that combines recreation, relaxation and natural beauty. The park covers over 900 acres of hardwood forests and gently rolling hills, with nearly a mile of shoreline along the expansive 11,400-acre Lake Greenwood, making it a haven for boaters, anglers, campers and nature enthusiasts.

Visitors can enjoy a variety of outdoor activities, including fishing, picnicing, kayaking, hiking, geocaching and birdwatching. The park features well-maintained trails that meander through tranquil woodlands and along scenic lakeside paths, providing opportunities to see native wildlife and seasonal wildflowers.

Family-friendly picnic shelters and playgrounds are available for gatherings and outdoor meals. Additionally, Lake Greenwood State Park has a popular campground with sites for both tents and RVs, many of which offer views of the lake and convenient access to the water.

A highlight of the park is the Drummond Center, which is home to South Carolina's only Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) museum. This unique museum pays tribute to the legacy of the CCC and its crucial role in developing state parks throughout South Carolina during the Great Depression. The exhibits feature original tools, photographs, uniforms, and stories from the young men who contributed to the building of many of the original South Carolina State Parks that still exist today.
