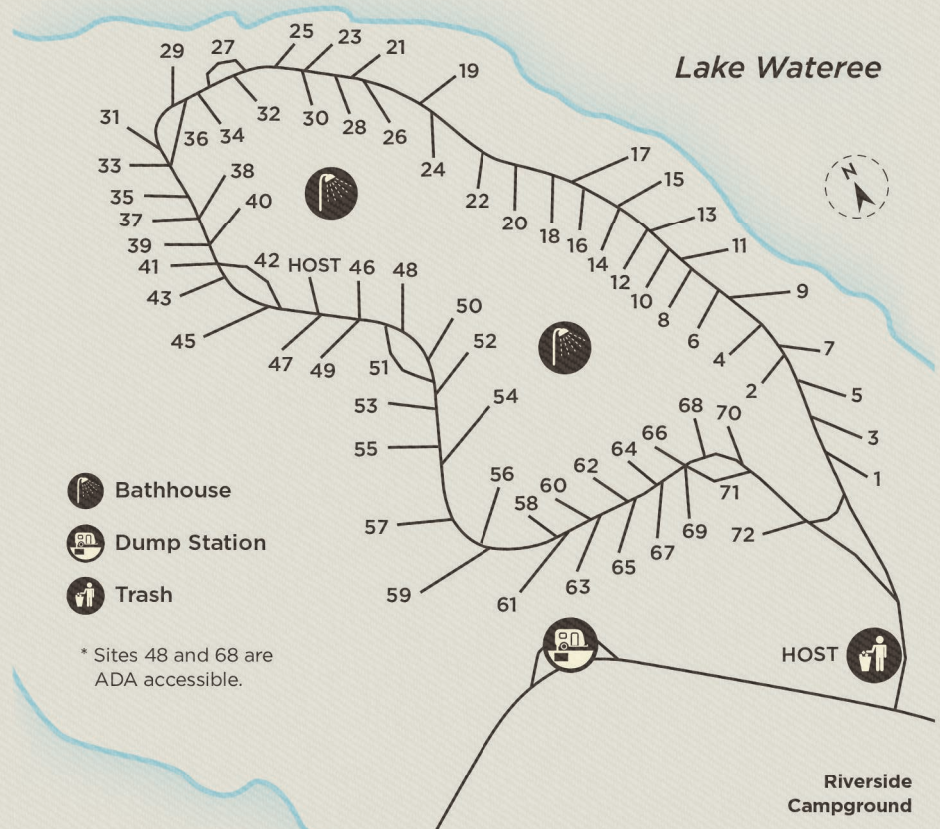

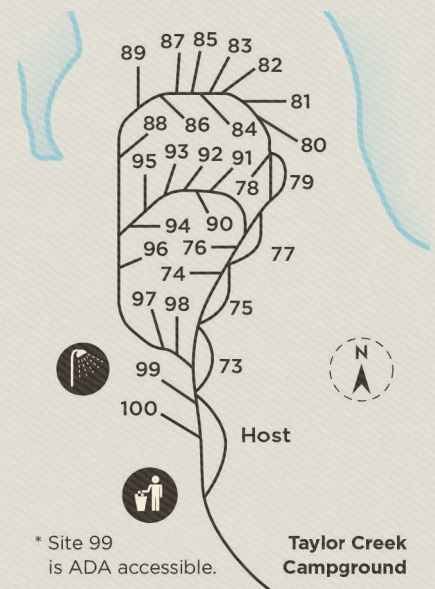

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Dial 911 in an EMERGENCY.
- Possession of firearms is prohibited.
- It is unlawful to possess or discharge any type of fireworks or explosives.
- All fires must be confined to designated grills or fire rings.
- It is unlawful to cut, damage or remove plants, shrubs or trees.
- It is unlawful to dispose of any waste, including gray water, in places or receptacles other than those designed specifically for that purpose.
- Pets must be on a leash of less than 6 feet in length at all times. Owners will be asked to remove pets that are noisy, dangerous or threatening to wildlife.
- Roadside parking is prohibited. Parking on unoccupied campsites is prohibited.
- Only licensed vehicles may be operated.
- All vehicles must remain in areas specifically intended for vehicular traffic.
- Golf carts must display a valid permit at all times and must be driven by a licensed driver.
- Campers are allowed either a maximum of one trailer/RV and one tent, or two tents per site.
- No more than six persons (or one family) may occupy the same site.
- It is unlawful to consume, or display in public, any alcoholic beverage.
- Campers must check in at 2 p.m. and check out at noon.
- Maximum length of stay on a particular site during periods of high demand is 14 nights. Longer stays may be allowed during periods of less demand.



- Cancellations and changes are subject to fees based on the notice given. Changes are not permitted unless requested at least four days in advance for camping. Early departures are subject to cancellation policies. Transaction fees are non-refundable.
- Registered campers may not change sites without permission from the park staff.
- Visitors not registered for an overnight stay are required to pay the park admission.
