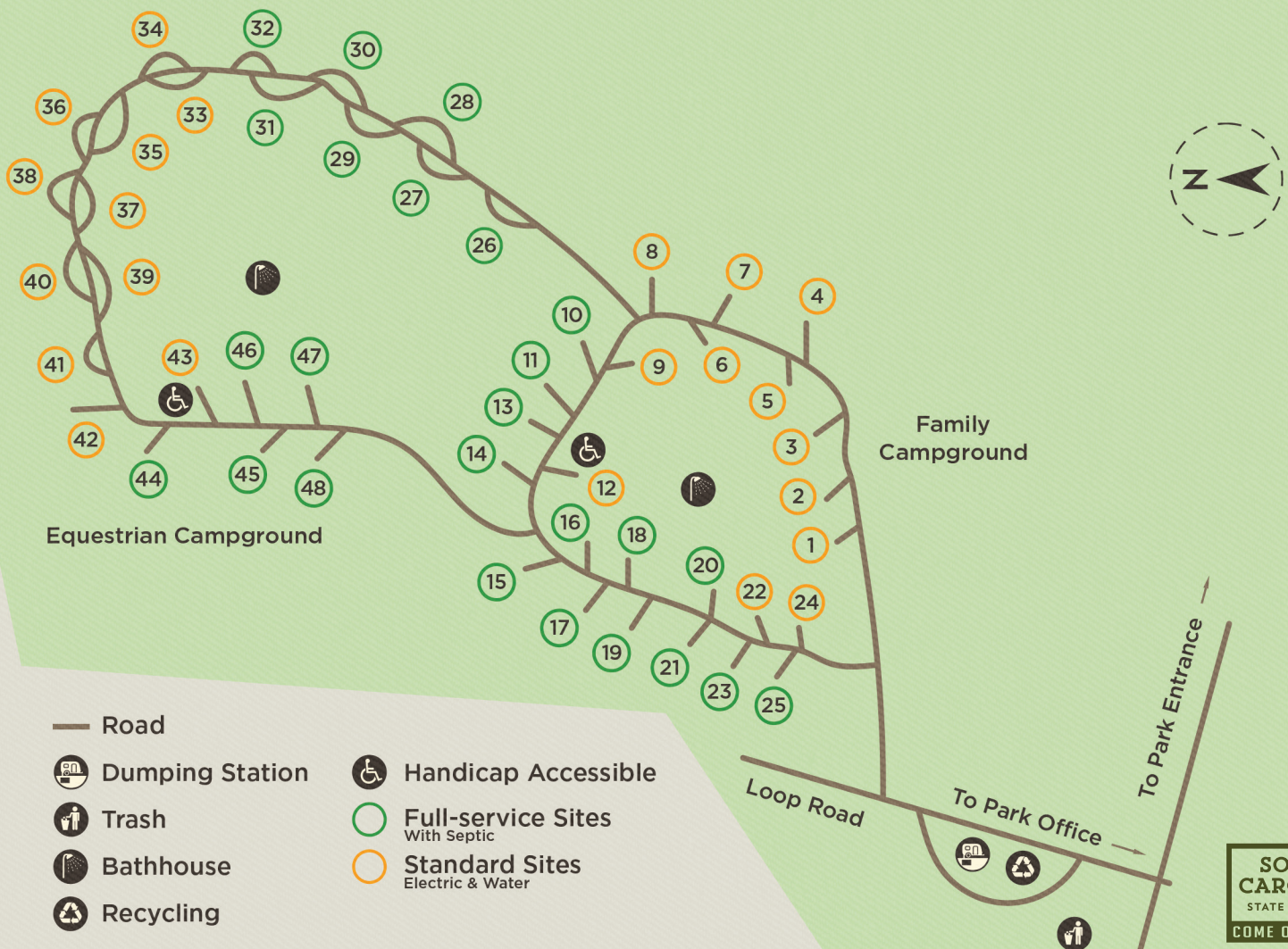

The most commonly asked questions are listed here. Please contact a park ranger if you have any other questions, and we hope you have a safe and memorable experience at Lee State Park.

ANSWERS TO COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

- Dial 911 in an emergency.
- Alcoholic beverages, firearms, fireworks, and generators are prohibited.
- Fires must be confined to designated firepits or grills.
- Golf carts must display a valid permit and be driven by a licensed driver.
- Quiet hours are 10 p.m.-7 a.m., no exceptions (including pets).
- Tents must be on tent pads or sand portion of standard (RV) sites; maximum 6 people per site.
- Each site may have 1 RV/trailer and 1 tent or 2 tents.
- Vehicles must remain on designated campsite only (not on grass, mulch, wood, shoulders, or unoccupied sites).
- Standard (RV) sites: maximum 2 vehicles (including the RV); extras must park in overnight guest area with valid tag.
- Registered campers may not move to different sites without staff permission.
- Maximum stay on one site: 14 nights.
- Reservations required; an empty site does not mean available.
- Cancellations/changes subject to fees; changes only with 4+ days' notice. Early departures follow cancellation policy. Transaction fees are non-refundable.
- South Carolina seniors (65+) and disabled residents may register at reduced rates; qualifying individual must be present for entire stay.
- Do not damage, cut, remove, or collect any trees, plants, rocks, or natural features (permit required for exceptions).
- Please take all trash to the collection site at campground entrance.
- Pets must be confined or leashed (max 6 ft), not left unattended, and removed if noisy, dangerous, or harassing wildlife. Pets are not allowed in cabins.
- Horses: No untrailered horses in family campground. Use wheelbarrows provided for manure disposal.
- A Health Certificate (30-day CVI or 6-month EECVI) is required when horses cross state lines.
- Please walk bicycles in equestrian campground.
