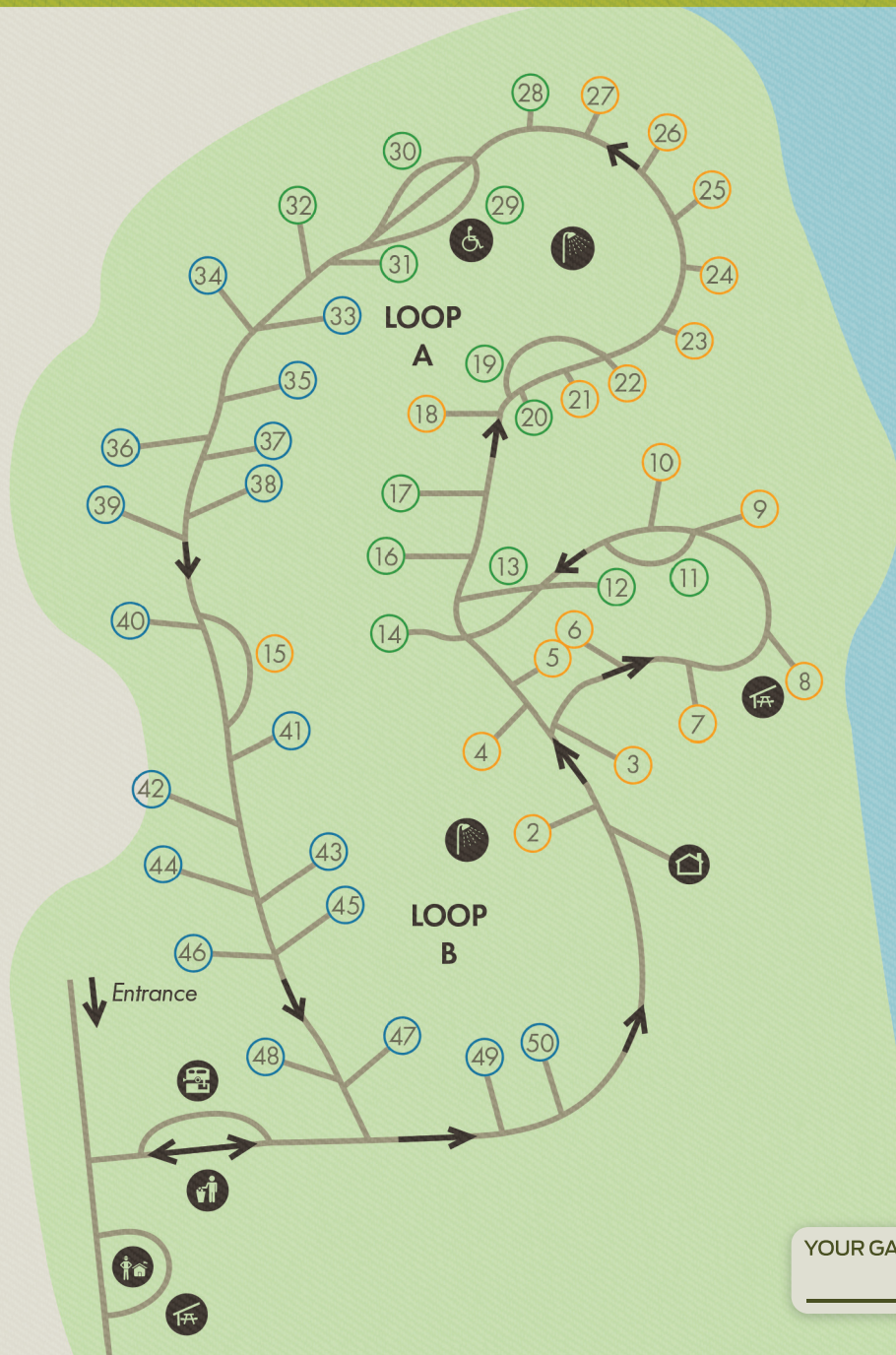

A complete list of rules and regulations is posted at each restroom and answers to the most commonly asked questions are listed below. Please contact a park ranger if you have any other questions. We hope you have a safe and memorable experience at Little Pee Dee State Park.



ANSWERS TO COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

- Dial 911 in an emergency
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited
- Firearms and fireworks are prohibited
- Quiet hours are from 10p.m. – 7a.m. NO EXCEPTIONS, including pets
- Tents must be on the tent pads or sand portion of the standard (RV) sites with a maximum of six people per site.
- Campers are allowed either a maximum of one trailer/RV and one tent, or two tents per site.
- All vehicles must remain on the designated campsite. No vehicles will be permitted to park on grass, mulch, wood or road shoulders.
- Standard (RV) sites are allowed a maximum of two vehicles at the site (this includes the RV); all additional vehicles can park in overnight guest area near the office and display a valid tag.
- All fires must be confined to designated firepits or grills.
- Parking on unoccupied campsites is prohibited.
- Generators are not allowed.
- Golf carts must display a valid permit at all times and must be driven by a licensed driver.
- Destroying, cutting, breaking, removing, defacing, mutilating, injuring, taking or gathering any tree, shrub, other plant or plant part, rock, mineral, or geological feature is prohibited, except by permit issued by the Department.
- Registered campers may not move to different sites without permission from the park staff.
- Maximum length of stay on a particular site is 14 nights.
- Cancellations and changes are subject to charges based on the notice given. Changes are not permitted unless requested at least four days in advance for camping. Early departures are subject to cancellation policies. Transaction fees are non-refundable.
- South Carolina senior citizens (age 65 and older) and disabled residents may register for a campsite at a reduced rate. The qualifying individual must be present for the duration of the stay.
- All campsites may be reserved in advance. An empty site does not mean it is an available site.
- Please take all trash to the collection site located at the entrance of the campground.
- Pets must be confined or on a leash no longer than six feet.
- Owners will be asked to remove pets that are noisy or dangerous, or that threaten or harass wildlife.
- Pets may not be left unattended.
- Pets are not allowed in the Cabin.
