OCONEE STATE PARK

Nestled at the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains, Oconee State Park has all the perks of a relaxing mountain getaway with access to numerous outdoor opportunities. A campground, rustic CCC-era cabins, lake with swimming area, canoe rentals and fishing opportunities are only a sample of the park's offerings.

There are over 10 miles of trails in the park as well as access to several regional trails. Oconee State Park serves as the Southern trailhead for the Foothills Trail, an 80-mile wilderness hike on South Carolina's Blue Ridge Escarpment. The Oconee Passage of the Palmetto Trail, a mountain-to-sea trail extending over 500 planned miles across South Carolina with 380 miles currently completed for mountain bikers and hikers, is also located at Oconee State Park. The Ross Mountain Passage of the Palmetto Trail connects Oconee State Park with Stumphouse Mountain Bike Park, offering mountain bikers additional riding opportunities.

Oconee is the perfect place for a family getaway with nostalgic activities, such as square dancing during the summer months, before Fourth of July celebration, Halloween festivities and a Christmas drive-through light show, among other holiday events.

Make plans to enjoy a weekend hiking, mountain biking, fishing, canoeing or just relaxing at Oconee State Park.
