8 a.m. – 5 p.m., daily

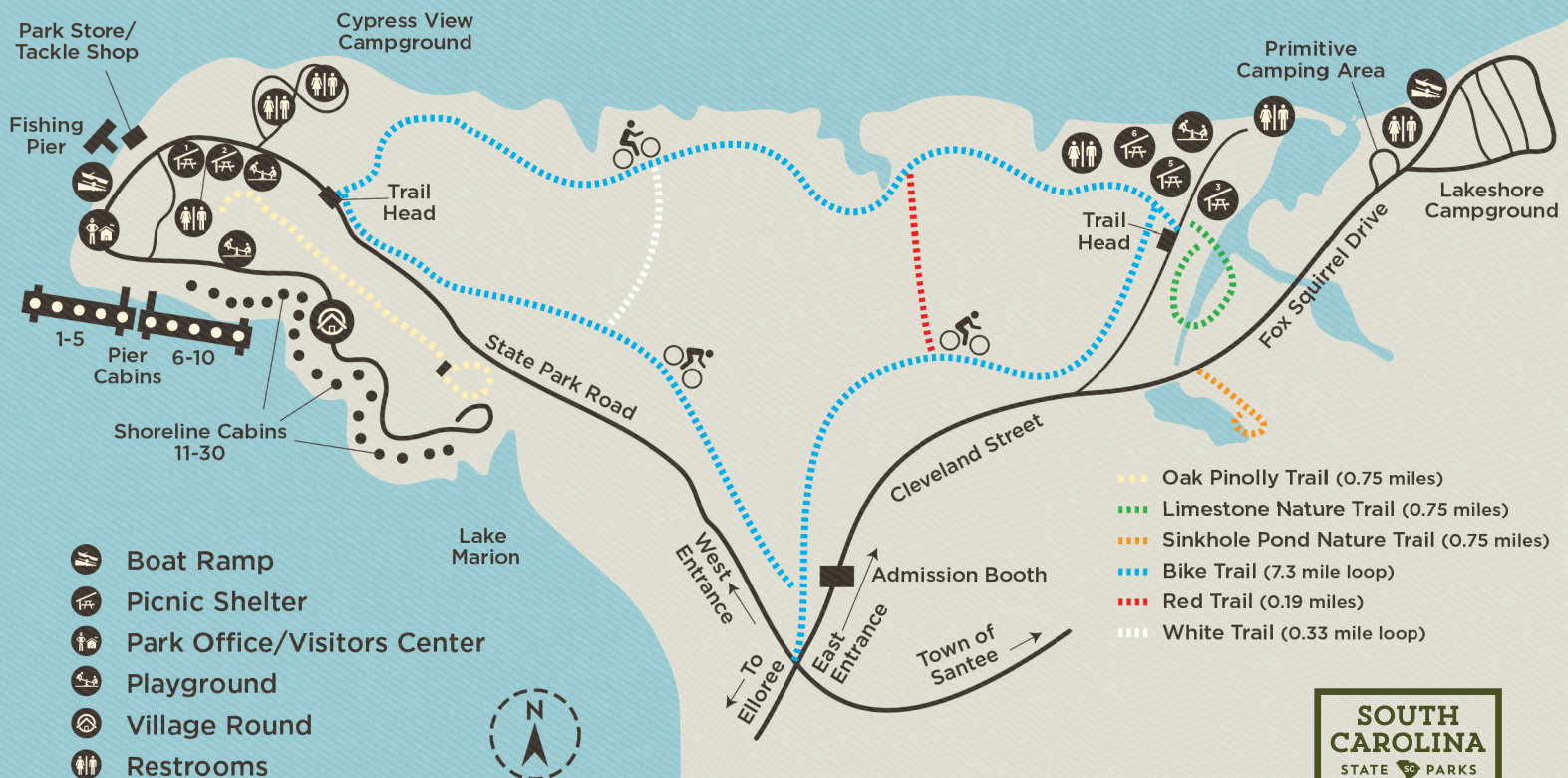
(Hours may vary during the winter months.)

All visitors are required to pay daily admission year round and display a valid pass. This includes visitors of registered cabin and camping guests. Admission collection locations include the park office, park store and admission booth during operational hours. After operational hours, please use one of the green iron ranger boxes located throughout the park.



SANTEE STATE PARK

Sprawled along the shores of Lake Marion in the heart of South Carolina's well-known Santee Cooper Country, Santee State Park is a 2,500-acre outdoor playground. Locals know the lake for its abundant population of large catfish—a few hours with a rod in your hand will explain why!

The park features two large campgrounds for RV and tent camping. Guests who prefer to spend the night indoors will find 30 rondette cabins, 10 of which sit on a pier over the lake and all of which have been attracting families for years. Other amenities and activities include the Village Round (a community meeting building), a park store with a Wi-Fi lounge, more than 10 miles of biking and hiking trails, abundant wildlife and two boat ramps.
