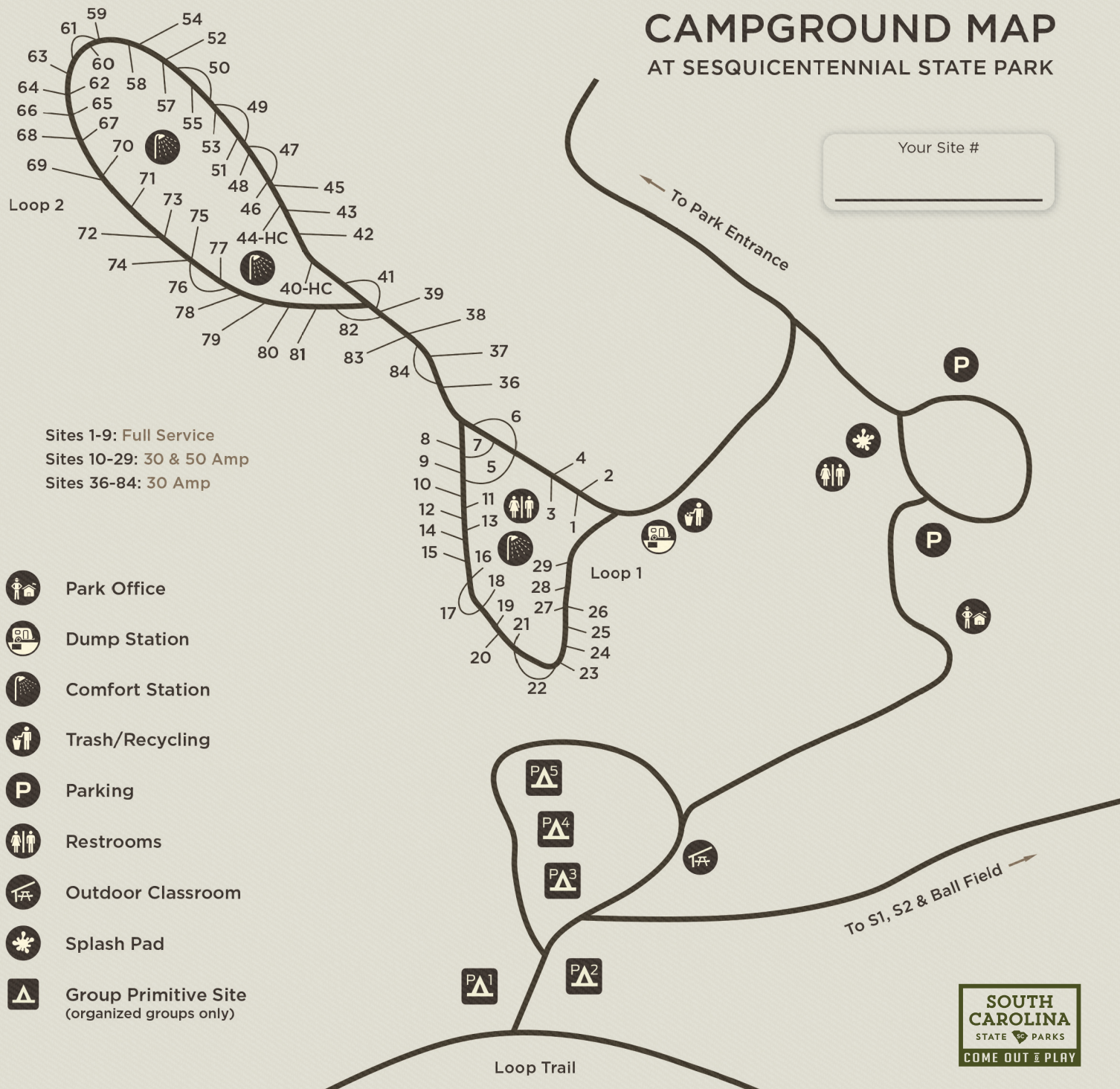

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Dial 911 in an emergency.
- Check-in time is 2 p.m. Check-out time is noon. Quiet hours are 10 p.m. - 7 a.m.
- No consumption or display of alcoholic beverages on state park property.
- The speed limit is 10 mph in the campground area.
- Roadside parking or parking on unoccupied campsites is prohibited.
- All fires must be confined to designated areas or grills.
- Possession of firearms is prohibited. Exceptions include certified park rangers and other personnel.
- Golf carts must be insured, display a valid permit and be driven by a licensed driver.

CAMPSITE RESTRICTIONS

- Overnight camping is allowed only to registered guests. Visitors not registered for an overnight stay are required to pay the park admission fee.
- Maximum length of campsite occupancy is 14 nights. See a park ranger for more information.
- A maximum of 1 trailer/RV and 1 tent or 2 tents only or 3 small 2-man tents only per site.
- One family or a maximum of six people are allowed per site.
- To register for a campsite, a member of the registered party (age 18 or older) must be present with the camping equipment and have proper identification.
- A maximum of two vehicles are allowed per site. Additional parking is available in the day use parking lot.
- Cancellations and changes are subject to fees based on the notice given.
- Registered campers may not change sites without permission of the park staff. Requests to transfer should be made at the park office.

- Camping equipment left unoccupied overnight is prohibited.
- It is unlawful to dispose of any waste (including gray water) in places or receptacles other than those specifically designed for that purpose. (Gray water includes car/RV washing.) Trash and recycling collection is located at the dump station. Campsites 1-9 have sewer hookups.
- Campground hosts are located throughout the campground if you need assistance.

CAMPERS WITHOUT ADVANCE RESERVATIONS

- Site availability is listed on the campground bulletin board located at the campground entrance.
- Choose an available site and register at the park office during office hours.
- All sites can be reserved. Sites may be reserved whether occupied or not.

PETS

- All pets must be caged or on a leash no longer than 6 feet or otherwise under physically restrictive control at all times. Owners will be asked to remove pets that are noisy, dangerous or threatening to wildlife.
- Owners must clean up after their pets. Dispose of pet waste in dump station.

HELP US BE GOOD STEWARDS OF OUR RESOURCES

- It is unlawful to possess or discharge any type of fireworks or other explosives.
- It is unlawful to cut, damage or remove any living plants, shrubs or trees.
- Help us keep wildlife wild by not feeding them.
- Prevent the spread of diseases and insects harmful to our trees. Buy firewood locally.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The gate combination is changed periodically. If you do not have the current gate combination, contact a park ranger.
