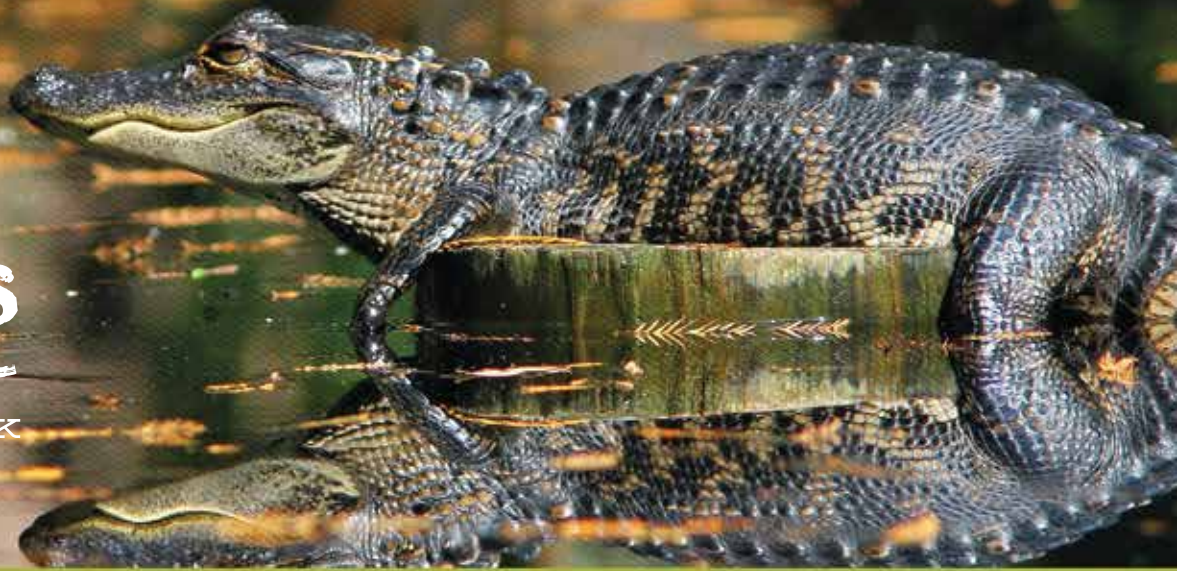

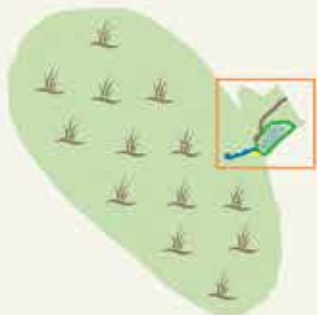

WOODS BAY STATE PARK

Get an up-close look at one of the last remaining large Carolina bays on the Mid-Atlantic Coastal Plain at Woods Bay State Park. Stroll along the 1,150-foot boardwalk to view alligators relaxing in the cypress tupelo swamp, or paddle on the one-mile canoe trail to marvel at herons, egrets and ospreys in their natural habitats. With a picnic shelter that can accommodate up to 25 guests, this park offers the perfect location to explore nature and connect with family.
