

Bledsoe Creek State Park

Campground Rules & Regulations

Speed Limits are strictly enforced. 15mph or less throughout the park.
Vehicles allowed in paved areas only.
No parking on roadways or grass. Park only in designated areas.
No idling. Please turn off your engines.

No bicycle riding after sunset.
Cycling on roads only. Trails are pedestrian only.
Children 15 years old & younger must wear helmets when riding bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades, scooters, etc.

No outside untreated firewood is allowed in the park. Only heat-treated firewood is allowed.
Do not leave fire unattended.
No tiki torches.

Do not burn trash in firepits, grills, etc.
Dumpsters are nearby for trash disposal.
No dumping of gray water on the ground.

Cutting of trees within the park is strictly prohibited.
Driving nails/spikes into park trees is strictly prohibited.

Alcoholic Beverages are only allowed on individual campsites. No alcohol allowed off reserved campsite, to include bathhouse, boat ramp, etc.

Pets must be on a leash at all times.
Even "down time" on a campsite.

Use of metal detectors is prohibited on park grounds.
Flying of drones on park grounds is prohibited.

No swimming or wading from park grounds, this includes boat docks/ramps.
