Rules & Regulations
All Harpeth River State park sites are day use only. No camping or overnight parking. Camping on private land subject to Trespassing Laws. Please observe park hours and plan trip accordingly. All gates to park sites and canoe access areas will be locked at the designated closing time.

If you are operating a boat, canoe, or kayak of any length, you must carry a US Coast Guard approved life jacket for each person on board. If stored, they should be readily accessible. Children 12 years of age and under must wear a properly fitted, US Coast Guard approved life jacket while underway in a boat.

Please help keep our parks and river clean. Pack it in and pack it out!
