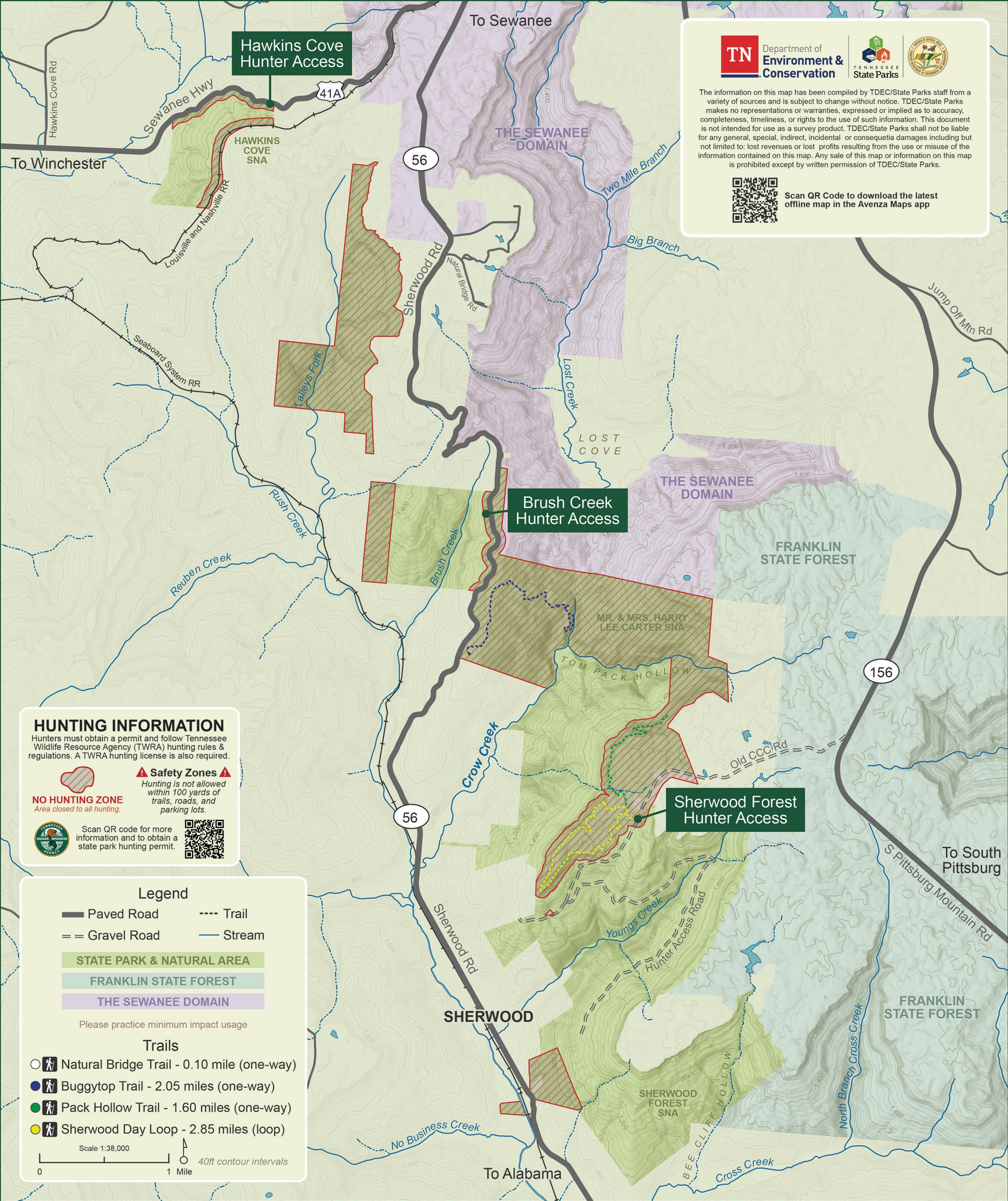

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HUNTING INFORMATION

Hunters must obtain a permit and follow Tennessee Wildlife Resource Agency (TWRA) hunting rules & regulations. A TWRA hunting license is also required.



NO HUNTING ZONE
Area closed to all hunting.

Safety Zones

Hunting is not allowed within 100 yards of trails, roads, and parking lots.
