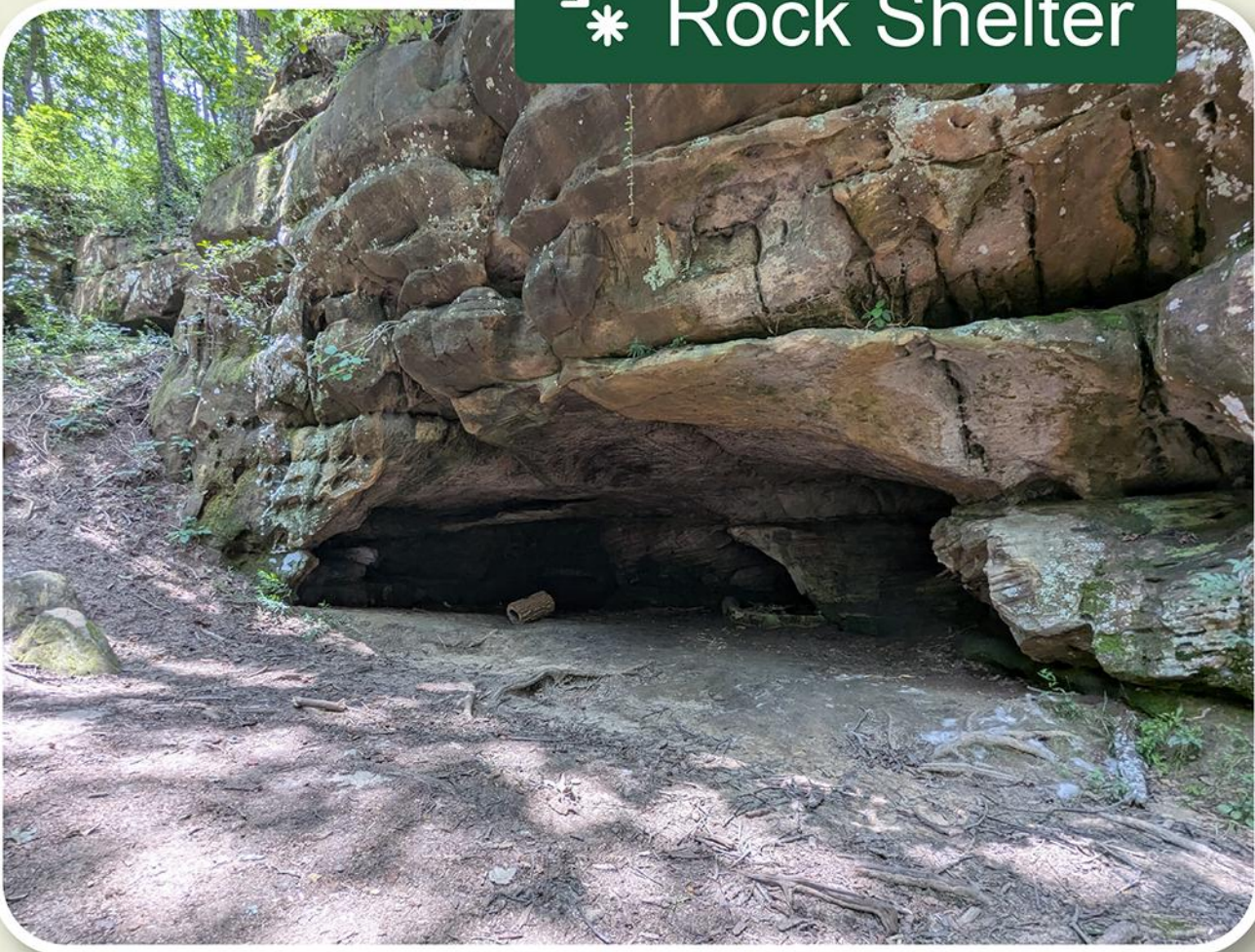

Welcome to **Natural Bridge State Natural Area**! The natural sandstone arch before you is 25 feet high with a span of 50 feet and provides a scenic view of Lost Cove. The cove is a large, closed valley where the water that flows into it disappears into the “Big Sink”, then re-emerges as Crow Creek from Buggytop Cave, which is within Mr. & Mrs. Harry Lee Carter State Natural Area. Both state natural areas are part of Head of the Crow State Park.

Trail Description: Starting from the parking lot, the trail descends 49 wooden and gravel steps to the top of a sandstone arch. The path crosses over top of the arch on a stone surface, without handrails. The trail turns left and descends uneven terrain and ends underneath the arch. The total length of trail is 1/10 mile with an elevation change of 63 feet.
