- Couchville Lake Trail - paved loop trail - 2.10 miles (Couchville Lake Area)
- Day Loop Trail - loop trail - 4.0 miles (Baker Grove Trailhead)
- Deer Trail - loop trail - 0.85 mile (Visitor Center)
- Inland Trail - loop trail - 0.70 mile (Area 4)
- Jones Mills Multi-Use Trails - 8.70 total miles
- Reading Ranger Story Trail - loop trail - 0.30 mile (Couchville Lake Area)
