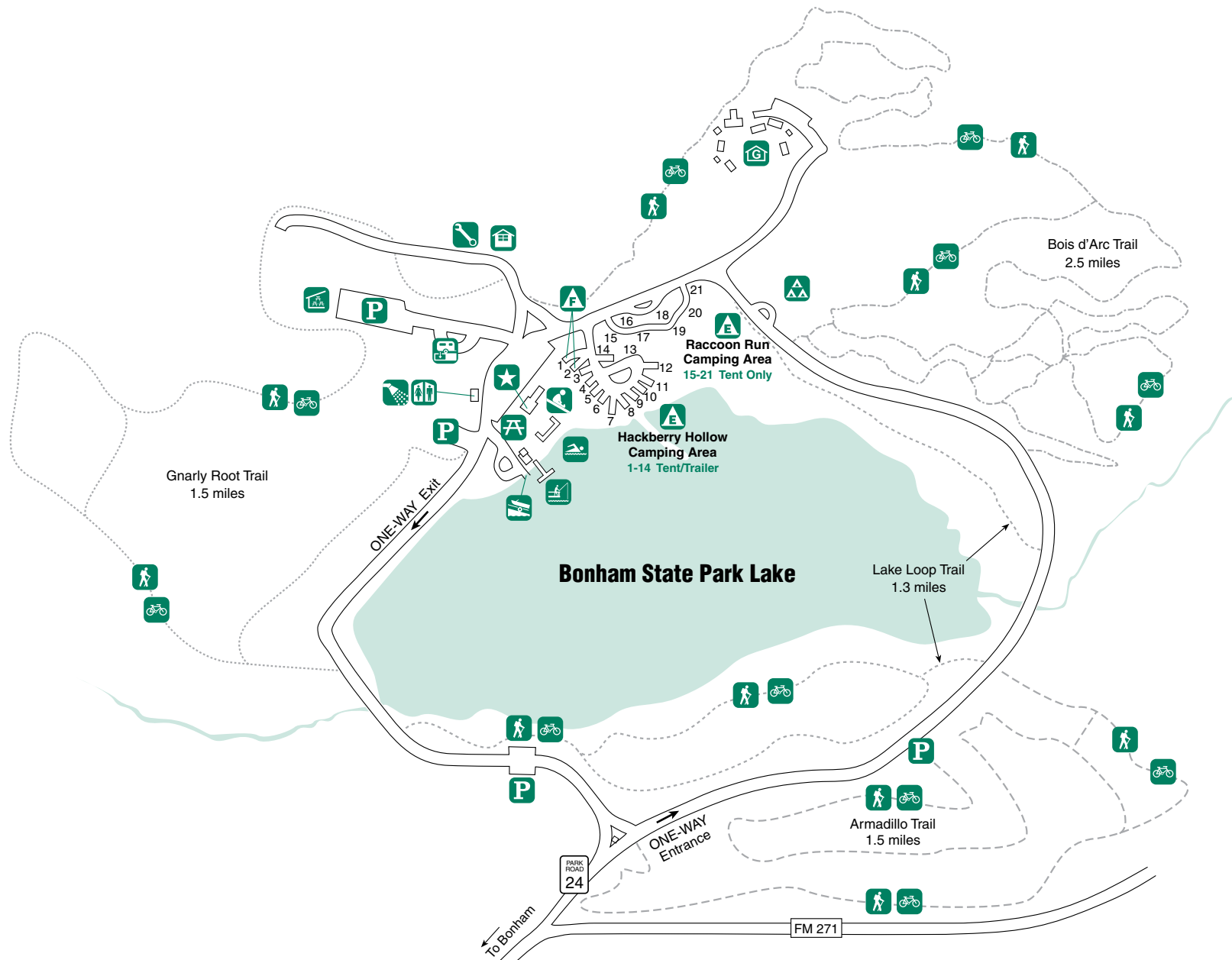

PLEASE NOTE

- CHECK OUT time is 12 p.m. or renew permit by 9 a.m. (pending site availability).
- Public consumption or display of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited.
- A maximum of eight people per campsite is permitted. Day-use visitors must leave the park by 10 p.m. Quiet hours are 10 p.m. – 6 a.m.
- GRAY WATER AND BLACK WATER MUST BE DISCHARGED ONLY AT DUMP STATIONS.
- Pets must be kept on leash and attended at all times. Please pick up after them.
- Valid permit is required on windshield of each vehicle in park. All vehicles are to remain on pavement.
- Stop the spread of invasive species. CLEAN, DRAIN and DRY your boat.
