PLEASE NOTE

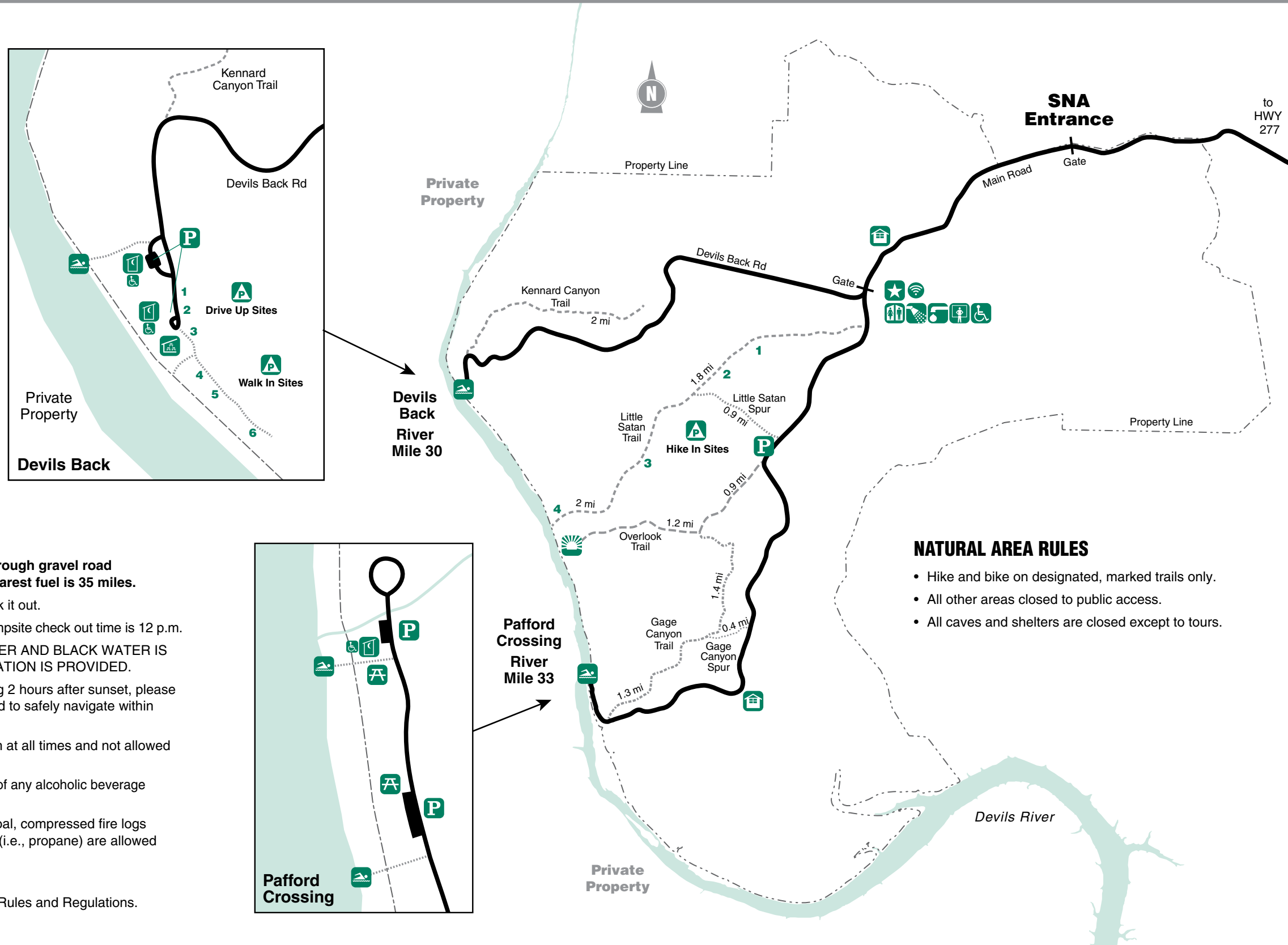
No paved roads. 9.5 miles of rough gravel road from HWY 277 to SNA HQ. Nearest fuel is 35 miles.

No trash service. Pack it in. Pack it out.

- Day-use closes at 10 p.m. Campsite check out time is 12 p.m.
- DISCHARGE OF GRAY WATER AND BLACK WATER IS PROHIBITED. NO DUMP STATION IS PROVIDED.
- Protect our dark skies. Starting 2 hours after sunset, please use minimal lighting as needed to safely navigate within your campsite.
- Pets must be on a 6-foot leash at all times and not allowed in park buildings.
- Public consumption or display of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited.
- No wood fires allowed. Charcoal, compressed fire logs and containerized fuel stoves (i.e., propane) are allowed for cooking.
- Swim at your own risk.
- Please review complete Park Rules and Regulations.

NATURAL AREA RULES

- Hike and bike on designated, marked trails only.
- All other areas closed to public access.
- All caves and shelters are closed except to tours.
