Devils River contains steep bluffs and rocky uneven trails. Use caution when hiking at night or with children.

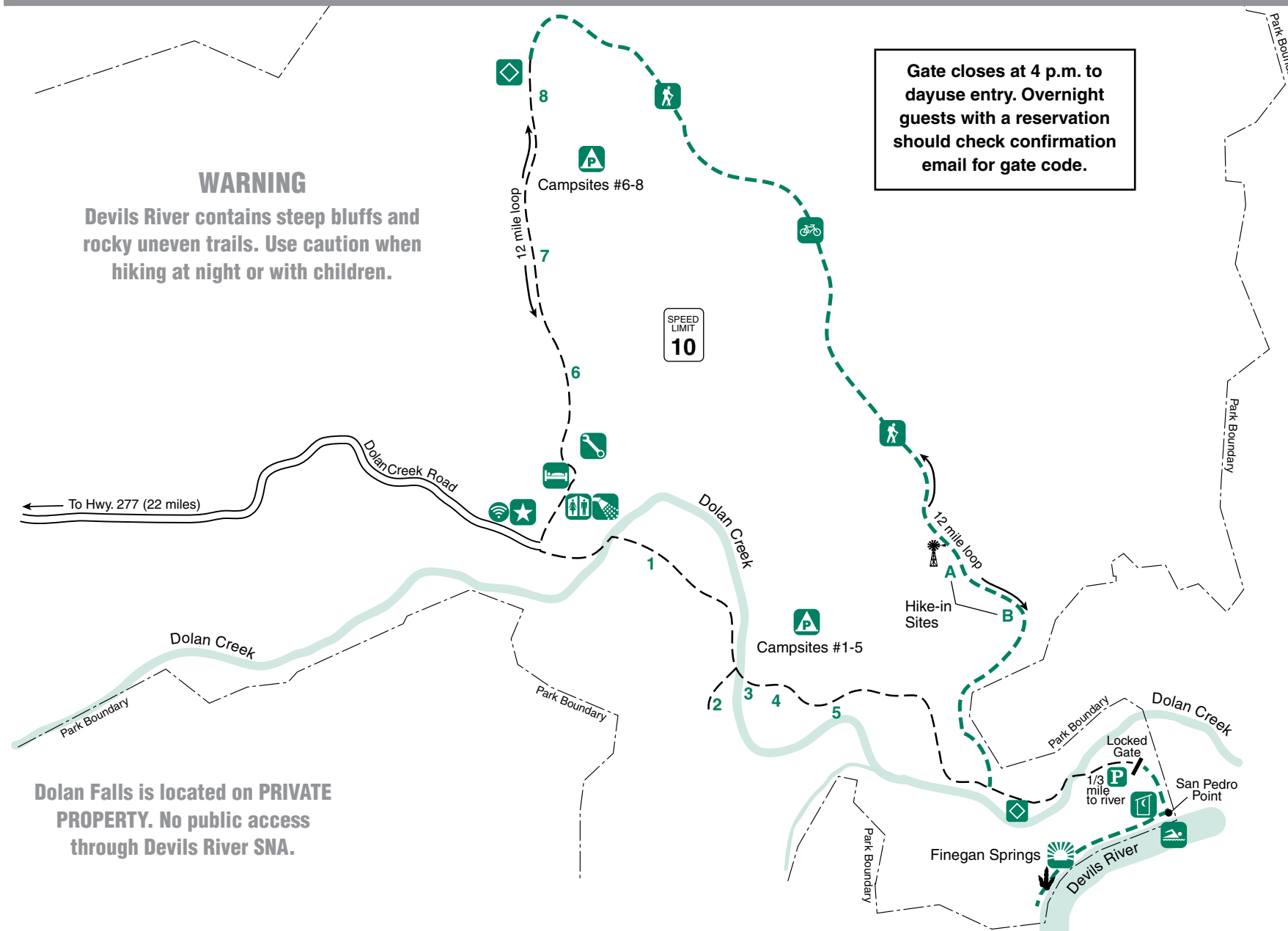
Gate closes at 4 p.m. to dayuse entry. Overnight guests with a reservation should check confirmation email for gate code.

PLEASE NOTE

No paved roads. 22 miles of gravel road into park. Roads subject to closure due to flooding.

No trash service.
Pack it in. Pack it out.

- Park closes at 10 p.m. Check out time is 12 p.m.
- Protect our dark skies. Starting 2 hours after sunset, please use minimal lighting as needed to safely navigate within your campsite.
- Pets must be on a 6-foot leash at all times and not allowed in park buildings.
- Public consumption or display of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited.
- No wood fires allowed. Charcoal, compressed fire logs and containerized fuel stoves (i.e., propane) are allowed for cooking.
- Swim at your own risk.
