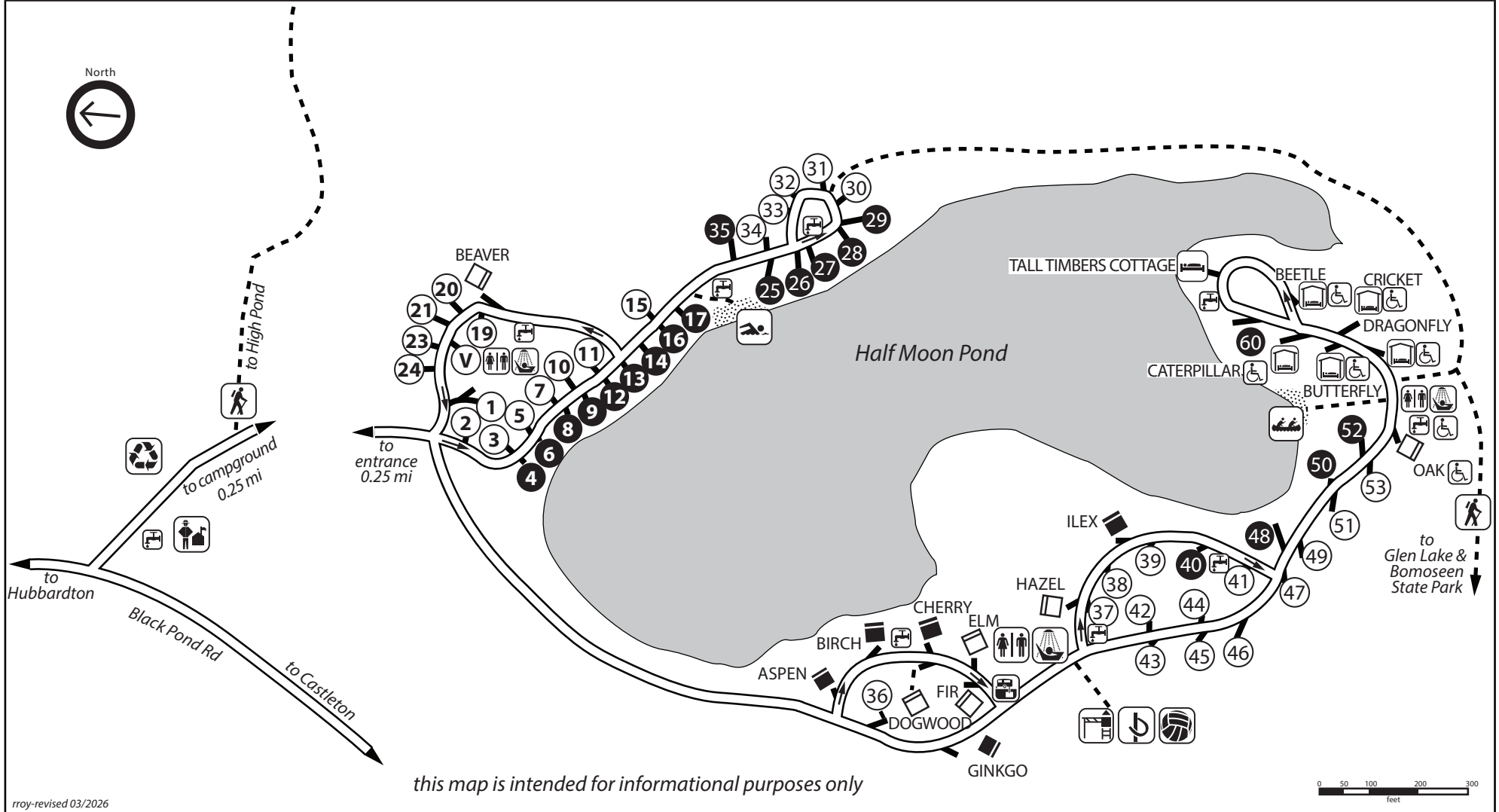

Half Moon Pond State Park

Nestled in the forest of 3,500-acre Bomoseen State Park sits the camping area comprising Half Moon Pond State Park. The park surrounds Half Moon Pond in the dense woods of a small, sheltered basin.

The campground offers camping for all tastes with its waterfront campsites, lean-tos and five furnished cabins. For those seeking more creature comforts, Tall Timbers Cottage, with its waterfront location and private boat dock, offers all the amenities of a fully furnished vacation home.

A perfect place for campers seeking a respite from the hustle and bustle of daily life, the park offers an expansive trail system. Hikers are likely to see a variety of wildlife including white-tailed deer or an occasional moose.

Rental boats are available for rent from the park office. Two small, sandy beaches provide for sunbathing and swimming. The pond has excellent fishing, for panfish, yellow perch, largemouth bass and rainbow trout. Other fishing opportunities can be found at nearby Glen Lake and Lake Bomoseen.

To the south lies the picturesque town of Fair Haven, the slate center of the nation, and Vermont's western gateway. Chartered and first settled in 1779, Fair Haven first prospered as a mill town. Later, in the mid-1800's, the first slate quarries opened, marking the beginning of an industry that continues to present day.
