## Welcome to Fort Flagler State Park

Please observe the following rules:

- You must show occupancy at your campsite to retain your site.
- Quiet hours start at 10:00 p.m.
- Keep vehicles on designated parking pads or in Extra Vehicle lots to help preserve natural resources.
- Two vehicle maximum per campsite. One vehicle is included with the price of a campsite (unless towed behind an RV). Extra vehicles must register for \$10 a night.
- If leaving early, please inform staff by stopping at the welcome station or office, calling or notifying the camp hosts.
- Pets must be on leash at all times, including in campsites, for their safety and the safety of visitors.
- Please help us keep our park clean by picking up pet waste.
- Bicyclists, please watch for blind spots and obey road laws.
- Help protect our park by not painting, carving or vandalizing structures or trees.
- All wildlife, rocks, driftwood, shells, artifacts and other natural or man-made features are protected and may not be disturbed or removed, including the collection of wood for campfires.
