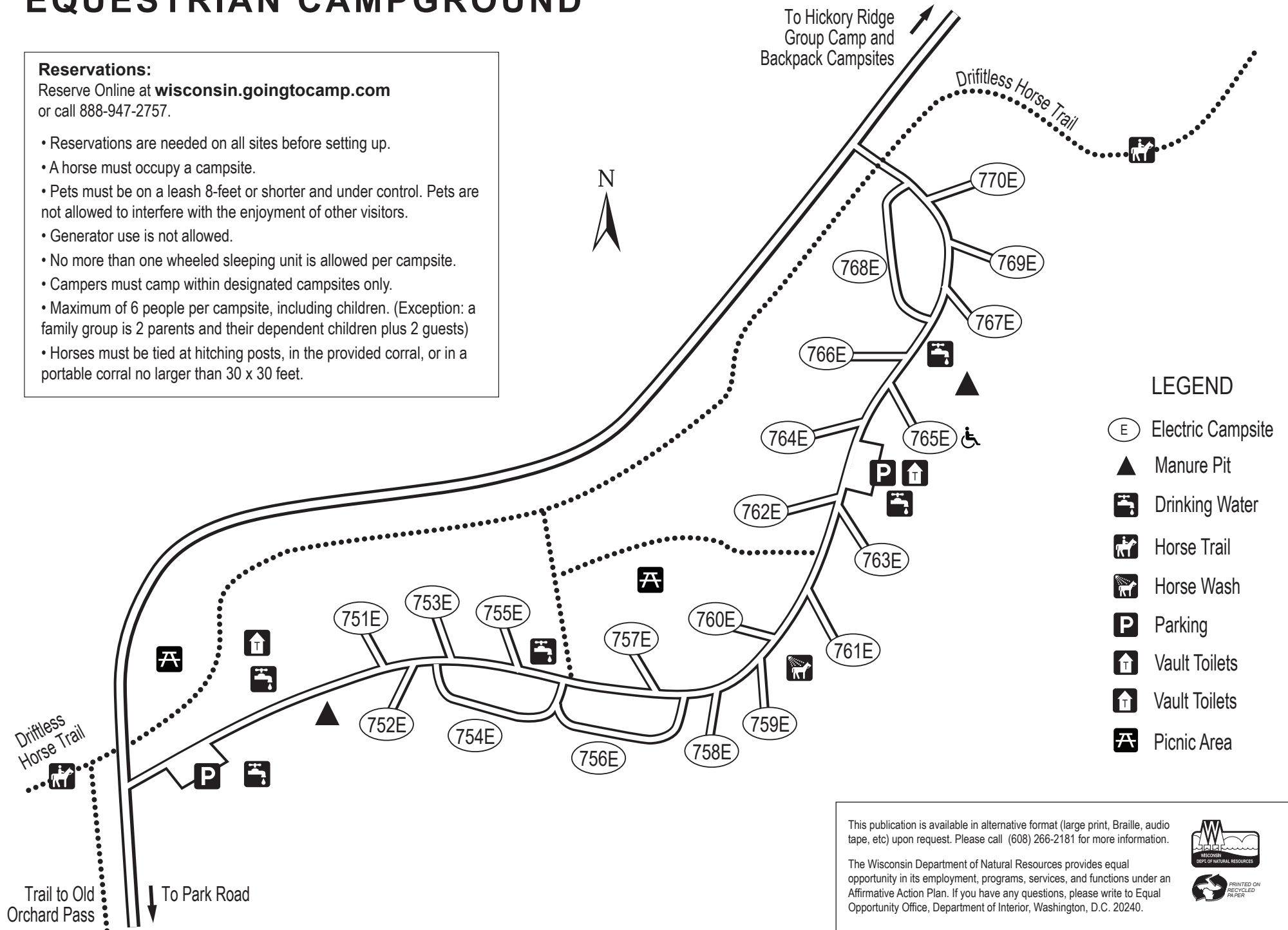


EQUESTRIAN CAMPGROUND

- Reservations are needed on all sites before setting up.
- A horse must occupy a campsite.
- Pets must be on a leash 8-feet or shorter and under control. Pets are not allowed to interfere with the enjoyment of other visitors.
- Generator use is not allowed.
- No more than one wheeled sleeping unit is allowed per campsite.
- Campers must camp within designated campsites only.
- Maximum of 6 people per campsite, including children. (Exception: a family group is 2 parents and their dependent children plus 2 guests)
- Horses must be tied at hitching posts, in the provided corral, or in a portable corral no larger than 30 x 30 feet.
