

WHITEFISH DUNES STATE PARK - WINTER MAP

TRAIL DESCRIPTIONS

MULTI-USE TRAILS (Snowshoe, Hike or Ski)

Black Trail Loop - 2.1 Mile

The exposed rock along the trail is dolomitic limestone bedrock and is part of the Niagara Escarpment that underlies all of Door County.

Brachiopod Trail - 1.5 Miles

This trail begins at the Nature Center and meanders along the shoreline with the Black Trail. Learn about the nature of Whitefish Dunes on this interpretive trail.

Cave Point Trail - 0.5 Miles

This trail travels along the shoreline, connecting the park to Cave Point.

North Green/Beach Loop - 2.0 Miles

Starts near the nature center. Complete a loop by crossing Clark Lake Road and head down the Third Beach access to hike the beach back to the nature center.

Red Pine Loop - 0.3 Miles

This short loop starts at the parking lot by Whitefish Bay Creek. Interpretive signs are posted along the way on this former commercial tree plantation.

Winter Trail Loop - 0.8 Miles

This loop comes off of the Red Pine Trail and travels around a portion of the Yellow Trail.

CROSS-COUNTRY SKI TRAILS (Classic Skiing)

Hiking, snowshoeing, pets and bikes are not allowed on cross-country ski trails when the trails are snow-covered, except where posted signs show multi-use trails.

Yellow Trail - 2.2 Miles (two-way ski trail)

The Yellow Trail starts at the Red Pine parking lot. The **Yellow Spur Trail** (one-way ski trail) creates a small detour.

Red Trail - 1.2 Miles (two-way ski trail)

Travel the length of the shoreline. When at the main parking lot near the Park Entrance, skiers take the Red Trail to connect to the rest of the ski trails.

South Green Trail - 1.0 Mile (one-way ski trail)

This trail starts at the western intersection with the Yellow Trail. It travels along a forested old dune.

Due to the sensitive nature of the dune ecosystems, no off-trail use is permitted in closed areas at the park.

Pets are allowed on the entire beach from Nov. 1 to April 1. Please stay off of ice formations for your safety.



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
