

Wyalusing Camping Information

Facilities

There are two family campgrounds with 109 individual campsites as well as a modern indoor group camp and a group tent campground.

Reservations

Reservations are required for all family and outdoor group campsites. Reservations can be made online at dnr.wi.gov, or by calling 888-947-2757. Reservations are accepted up to 11 months in advance of your planned date of occupancy. Reservations are also available for the Indoor Group Camp and park shelter buildings.

Group Camping

There are two group camps. The outdoor group camp has five sites with a capacity of 160 persons. The Hugh Harper Indoor Group Camp has a capacity of 108 persons and consists of four dormitory buildings that house 27 persons in each, and a main lodge with fully equipped kitchen and dining facilities. Groups must furnish their own food and bedding. Reservations for the indoor group camp are also accepted up to 11 months in advance of your planned date of occupancy.

Electricity

Electrical outlets for campers are provided at several campsites in the Homestead and Wisconsin Ridge campgrounds.

Showers

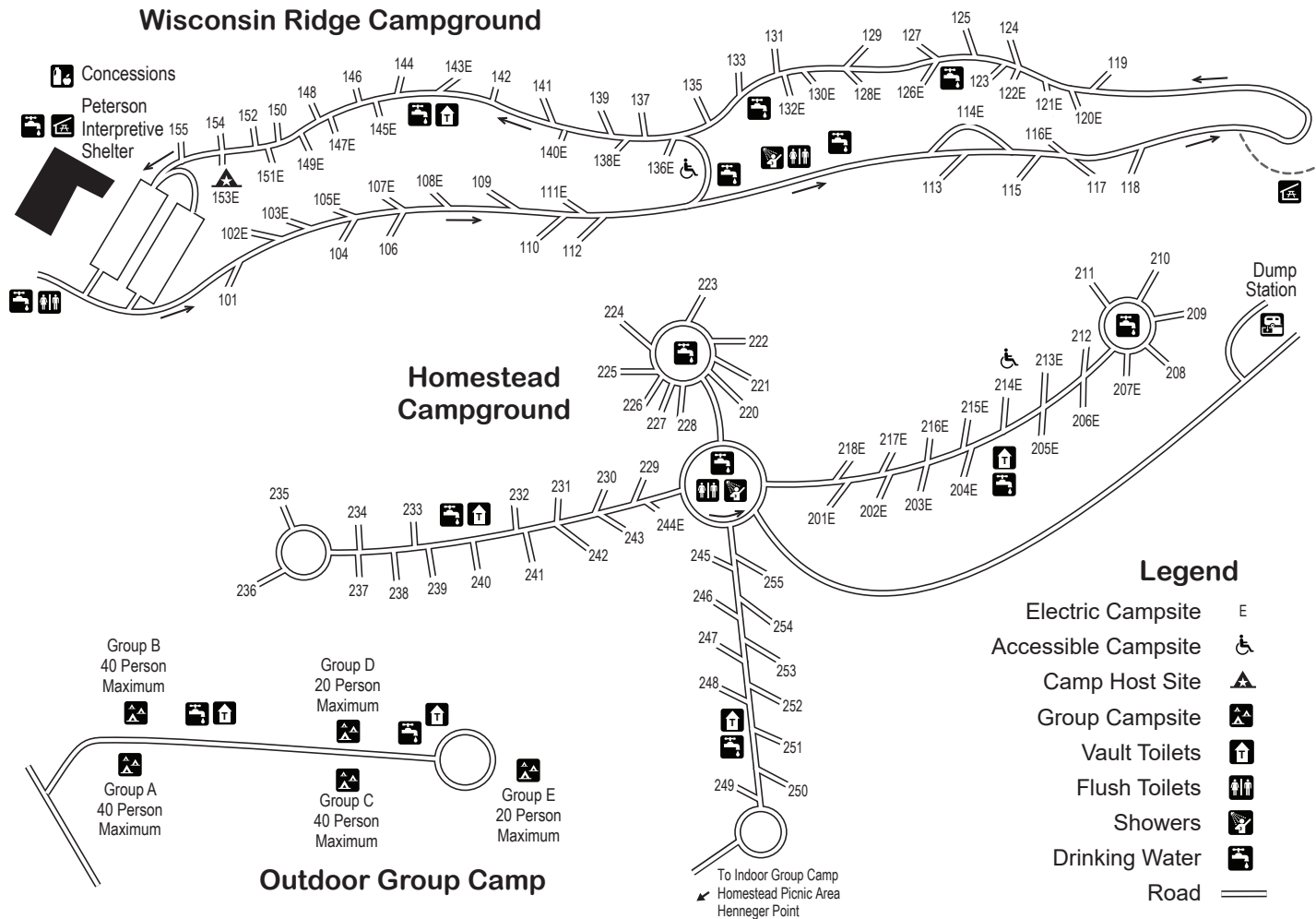
Showers for all campers are in the Wisconsin Ridge and Homestead campgrounds.

Firewood

Firewood can be purchased at the concession stand within the Peterson Interpretive Shelter next to the Wisconsin Ridge Campground.



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
